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Telehealth Navigators and Community Health Workers are recruited from the local community where the library is located



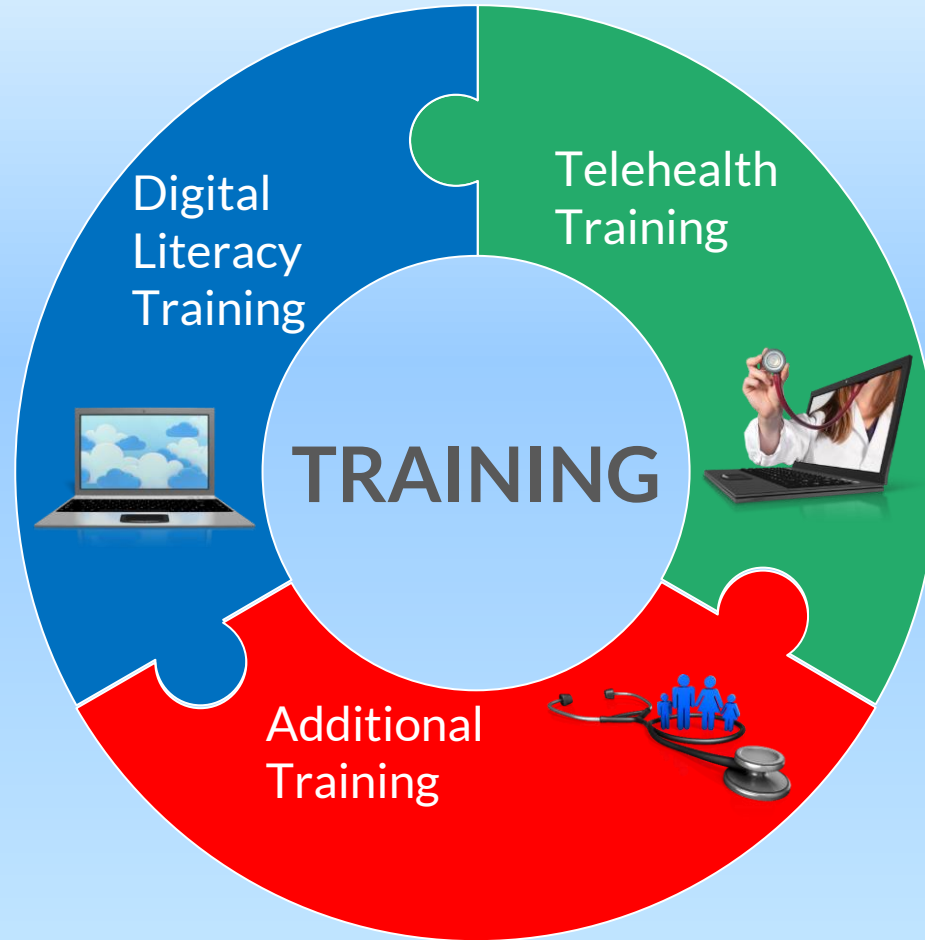
Services include learning how to navigate digitally, learning about telehealth, having a telehealth visit, and borrowing a hotspot and Chromebook to do telehealth at home.

Training on how to assess digital literacy and help teach digital literacy.

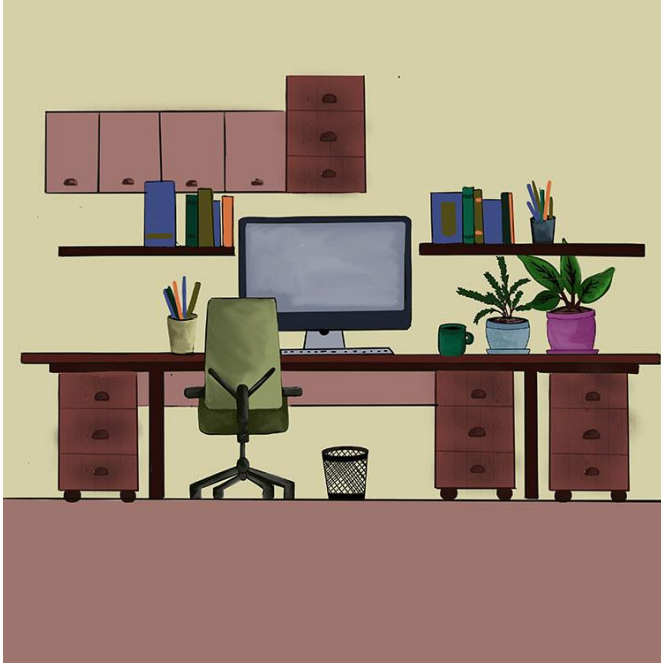


Training on the basics of telehealth and how to use telehealth to access healthcare.

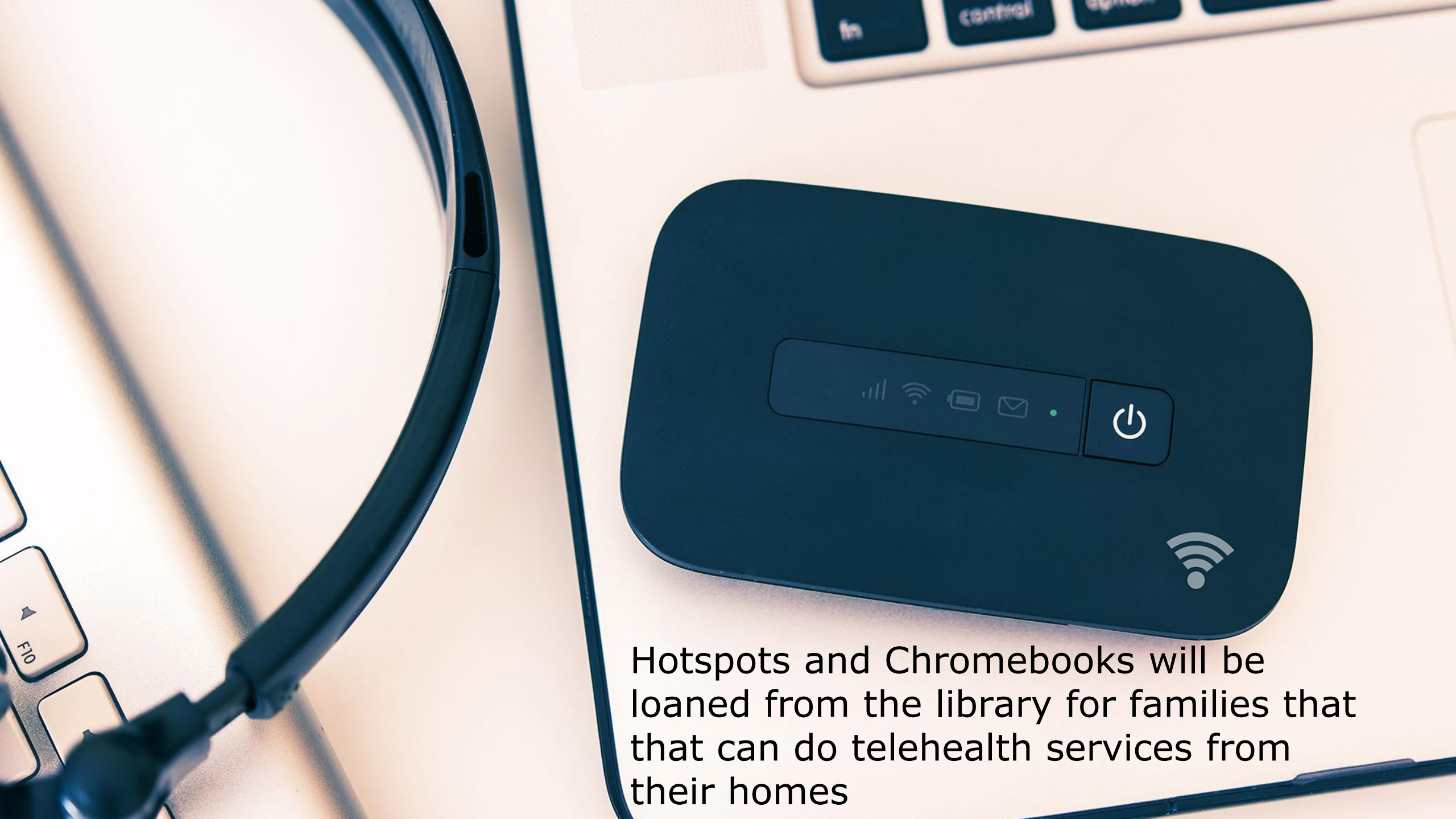
