The following House Resolutions are still are moving through the legislature. Both measures have passed out of their respective House committees and will cross over to the Senate for consideration.

HCR19 Urging the Dept of Transportation Services of the C&C of Honolulu to conduct a feasibility study of widening the portion of University Avenue between Maile Way and Oahu Avenue.

HCR78 Urging the Department of Facility Maintenance of the C&C of Honolulu to conduct and assessment and prepare and execute a plan to maintain Manoa Stream.


