A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ELECTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 11-122, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 3 "(c) The office of elections shall prepare and mail with
- 4 each ballot for a primary election a notice to voters that a
- 5 digital voter information guide is available on the office of
- 6 elections website. The notice shall be sent by electronic mail
- 7 to all voters with special needs who have registered to receive
- 8 alternate format ballots. The office of elections shall print
- 9 and mail a physical copy of the digital voter information guide
- 10 to any voter upon request."
- 11 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 13 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 for
- 14 the office of elections to print and mail a physical copy of the
- 15 digital voter information guide to any voter upon request.
- 16 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the office of
- 17 elections for the purposes of this Act.

- 1 SECTION 3. In accordance with section 9 of article VII of
- 2 the Hawaii State Constitution and sections 37-91 and 37-93,
- 3 Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined that the
- 4 appropriations contained in H.B. No. , will cause the state
- 5 general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be
- 6 exceeded by \$ or per cent. In addition, the
- 7 appropriation contained in this Act will cause the general fund
- 8 expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be further
- 9 exceeded by \$ or per cent. The combined total
- 10 amount of general fund appropriations contained in only these
- 11 two Acts will cause the state general fund expenditure ceiling
- 12 for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be exceeded by
- 13 \$ or per cent. The reasons for exceeding the
- 14 general fund expenditure ceiling are that:
- 15 (1) The appropriation made in this Act is necessary to
- serve the public interest; and
- 17 (2) The appropriation made in this Act meets the needs
- 18 addressed by this Act.
- 19 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
- 20 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
