A. The primary mission of the State of Hawaii, Department of Defense, is to enable a safe, secure, and prosperous Hawaii. To accomplish this the department takes an all of community approach to prepare the state for catastrophic natural, or manmade disasters. The department coordinates preparedness activities that improve the state's ability to prevent an event; build resilience to absorb the effects of a disaster; and by organizing capabilities, capacities, and authorities to rapidly respond to and recover from catastrophic disasters.

Strategic Objectives, Goals, and Performance Metrics for 2022 - 2025:

- 1. Operationalize the Office of Homeland Security
 - a. Codify the Hawaii State Fusion Center into law
 - b. Build personnel intel and cyber security analyst capacity
 - c. Finalize the state's Homeland Security Strategy
- 2. Reorganize the Hawaii Emergency Management Agency
 - a. Update organizational chart
 - b. Convert branch chief and key positions to exempt
- 3. Improve the state's preparedness and resiliency to catastrophic and manmade disasters
 - a. Continue to increase Hawaii Hazard and Awareness Resiliency Program communities
 - b. Construct new Emergency Management Operations Center in Central Oahu
- B. As a result of the current fiscal constraints, the department's near-term budget request focuses on converting key HI-EMA positions from Civil Service to Exempt, hurricane hardening of the department's headquarters building, siren upgrades, and improvement of the West Hawaii Veterans Cemetery.
- C. The coronavirus pandemic impacted all of us. DOD responded by maximizing federal dollars in support of the State of Hawaii. Internally, federal dollars were used to fund critical positions that were defunded in FY21, in addition to funding project positions created to respond to this pandemic.
- D. Federal Funds: The Department's FY2021 Federal Funds operating budget is ~\$84 million. The federal funds are distributed through the National Guard Bureau based upon the Master Cooperate Agreement for the various programs that include the Hawaii National Guard and Youth Challenge Academy. Additional Federal Funds for FY21, not included in the operating budget, are received from FEMA (~\$61M for COVID & \$3.5M EMPG). OHS garnered \$7.8M in grants and OVS ~\$51M for various cemetery projects and VA Care Home. Approximately \$6M in federal funds are in jeopardy through the loss of positions that require a state match. 85 positions were defunded in FY21 (18% of the department). We request to work with the legislature to trade off for some of the 68 positions that are critical for DOD to meet mission requirements.

- F. The Department of Defense prioritizes its budget requests based on our ability to meet mission requirements and the safety of our personnel and the people of Hawaii. Upon receipt of the Department of Budget and Finance's Finance Memorandum 17-12 for supplemental budget preparation, the DOD takes the following actions:
 - 1) ASO requests all programs to create and submit Operating Budget and Capital Improvement Project requests that meet the B&F budget policies and guidelines.
 - 2) ASO receives all program requests and reviews, clarifies and corrects all submissions, as needed. Operating and CIP budget requests are recommended in priority order for the TAG's review, modification and approval.
 - 3) Final prioritized budget requests are compiled and submitted to B&F for review and approval by the submission deadline.
 - 4) B&F questions and comments are fielded and responded to. B&F budget recommendations are received.
 - 5) Appeal to Governor's Office made for budget requests denied or amended by B&F, as required.
 - 6) Approved budget requests are finalized and submitted to B&F for Legislative submittal by submission deadlines.
- G. Major Adjustments contained in the budget request:
 - 1) Due to the COVID 19 pandemic, the State budget deficit required dramatic reduction. Upon instruction from the Governor, the Department of Defense (DOD) is planning to close the Hawaii National Guard Youth Challenge Academy in Hilo, Hawaii. (-10.25 temp: -\$612,797 A; -31.50 temp: \$-\$2,361,868P each year.
 - 2) The DOD's remaining request is to transfer/trade off within their own Program ID. These are a zero-sum request. These requests will assist the DOD in sustaining operations.
 - 3) Also, due to the COVID pandemic emergency and the requirement to adjust to emergent challenges, DOD requested and was approved in the executive Budget to maintain the Airport Thermal Screening Devices. This request was to fund the maintenance contract. (\$1,000,000A each year). However, this requirement is no longer required.
