Strong Cross-Sector Collaboration

- Homelessness
 - Working Group: City EMS, CORE, DCS, HPD/State DOH, DHS, Queens, Non-Profits (IHS/PIC)
 - Meet and strategize on homeless services, funding and transition to shelters, transitional housing and permanent housing
 - City operated Lē'ahi hospital
 - Waikiki Vista emergency shelter
 - A'ala medical respite and transitional housing
 - CORE mobile medical triage
 - HONU
 - Iwilei Center medical triage and transitional shelter (in-process)

Strong Cross-Sector Collaboration

- Affordable Housing
 - Working Group: City Housing, DLM, DPP, DCS
 - Meet and strategize on executing in affordable housing/TOD
 - Private Activity Bonds in collaboration with HHFDC
 - City lands/HHFDC financing to developers
 - Bill 7 projects (pre-construction incentives/post COO grant)
 - Iwilei acquisitions, rail station and TOD
 - Other affordable housing projects
 - Infrastructure to meet AH development

Strong Cross-Sector Collaboration

- Skyline Rapid Transit - State/Federal/City funding
 - 2023 - Operations from East Kapolei to Aloha Stadium
 - 2024 - Amended FFGA with restoration of federal funding
 - 2025 - Forecasted operations from Aloha Stadium to Middle Street
 - Joint Base Pearl Harbor Hickam
 - Daniel K. Inouye International Airport
 - Construction of the locally preferred alternative fully paid in 2030

Strong Cross-Sector Collaboration

- Public Safety - City/State/Federal law enforcement
 - Increased gun violence/crime Waianae Coast
 - Aircraft accident - Daniel K. Inouye International Airport
 - 2025 New Years Illegal Aerial Fireworks
 - Wildland Fire preparation and mitigation

Other City-State Collaborations

- Wahiawā Civic Center – DCS Satellite City Hall
- City DTS and State HDOT
 - State-of-the-Art Traffic Signal Controller System
 - Electric Fleet of Public Vehicles
 - Safe Streets/Traffic Calming/Complete Streets/Vision Zero
 - Maximize federal funding opportunities
- City landfill – preferably outside the aquifer (State action to facilitate)

City Priorities

- Department of Housing and Land Management
 - First fully functional housing office since 1998
 - Iwilei TOD - 5+ acres and growing
 - \$2.7M master planning grants
 - Development Solicitations
 - Chapter 38 direct leases

City Priorities

- Department of Planning and Permitting
 - People, Processes and Technology
- Honolulu Department of Ocean Safety
- Economic Development
 - Bill 59 - Film production studios
- Deregulation
- Cost of Living
