Chair Luke, Vice Chair Cullen, and Members of the Committee on Finance:

OVERVIEW

The mission of the Department of Public Safety (PSD) is to uphold justice and public safety by providing correctional and law enforcement services to Hawaii's communities with professionalism, integrity, and fairness.

The Department is able to accomplish this mission through three major Divisions: Corrections, Law Enforcement and General Administration under nineteen (19) Program IDs with 2,782.60 authorized permanent positions for all means of funding. Our overall goal is to protect people and property from injury and loss caused by criminal actions. PSD programs provide and coordinate specialized services, facilities, security, and legislation to preserve the peace; to prevent and deter crimes; to detect, apprehend, detain, and rehabilitate criminals; and where appropriate, to compensate victims of crime. Under Corrections Division are 13 Program IDs with 2,146.0 authorized positions, Law Enforcement Division with 2 Program IDs and 416.0 authorized positions, General Administration with 139.0 authorized positions, and two administratively attached agencies: the Hawaii Paroling Authority with 68.0 authorized positions.

The Department continues to face challenges in Corrections and Law Enforcement and appreciate your understanding and responsiveness, as reflected in the appropriations we have been given in the past. We take this opportunity to describe the most significant challenges and the activities underway.

• <u>COVID-19 Pandemic</u>: We are currently dealing with largest COVID-19 outbreak in the State at the Halawa Correctional Facility (HCF) which began last month. We have also addressed outbreaks at the Oahu Community Correctional Center (OCCC) and at the Waiawa Correctional Facility (WCF). We are also monitoring the outbreak at our contracted facility, the Saquaro Correctional Center (SCC) in Arizona. The Sheriff's division also had to address detection of the virus in the court's cellblocks,

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which affected staff and detainees. PSD's correctional facilities have been successfully implementing their pandemic plans when situations arise. These outbreaks have overwhelmed PSD's heath care and security staff due to staffing shortages. Further, due to overcrowded conditions and the age of our facilities, it is difficult to quarantine and isolate inmates who tested positive. There has been minimal relief to population increase even though inmates have been released pursuant to Hawaii Supreme Court orders and Hawaii Paroling Authority releases.

PSD's Sheriff and Narcotics Enforcement Division (NED) will play a critical role in the Hawaii Department of Health COVID-19 Vaccination Plan. The successful deployment of the vaccination plan will support the State's efforts to implement a comprehensive program to reduce COVID-19 related illnesses, hospitalizations, and deaths, and to help restore societal functioning. PSD's LE assets will be tasked to secure the receiving, storing, transporting and orderly distribution of the vaccine. NED special agents and deputy sheriffs will be responsible for 24/7 monitoring of the supply of the vaccine; and to further investigate any disruption or theft of the supply chain.

- Jail Overcrowding: Expansion projects for the neighbor island jails faced a setback due to higher than anticipated construction bid cost. Our CIP request addresses this challenge with the lapsing of funds for the Kauai Community Correctional Center (KCCC) project to fund the completion of the Hawaii Community Correctional Center (HCCC) and Maui Community Correctional Center (MCCC) housing projects. Although, these expansions will not fully address the overcrowding, they will provide significant relief to existing conditions. The two projects for the Women's Community Correctional Center (WCCC) are moving forward. The new housing will add up to 172 beds and the renovation to the Ho'okipa Cottage will add up to 65 beds.
- Deteriorating Facilities: Some of you have toured our facilities and witnessed the aged, deteriorating, and increasingly overcrowded conditions, which present serious safety and operational challenges every day for staff and inmates across the state. Most recently, on September 8, 2020 a disturbance happened at A-Wing of the Wainuenue housing of the HCCC that caused damage to that building. And not to forget, the March 11, 2019 riot that happened at the MCCC that heavily damaged Module B and also affected the adjacent Module A, C and D.
- <u>Vacancies</u>: Table 3 shows that PSD has a total authorized permanent position count of 2,782.60 from all means of funding. 2,684.60 are general funded positions, of

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> which 1,683.0 are uniform positions (63%). The 1,683.0 uniform positions are broken down into 1,411.0 Adult Corrections Officers (ACO) and 272.0 Deputy Sheriff positions. Table 11 lists a total of 463.50 vacancies as of November 30, 2020 for all means of funding. 420.50 of these vacancies are general funded. We report that 222.0 are ACOs and 32.0 are Deputy Sheriffs for a total of 254.0 uniform position vacancies, representing 60% of the general funded vacancy list.

• **Population Management:** Since the passage of the Justice Reinvestment Act (JRI) in 2012, PSD has made significant progress and improvement in the processing and rehabilitative programming of inmates and parole violators. JRI-inspired operational changes have also resulted in increased amounts of restitution collected from offenders, increased numbers of inmates assigned to re-entry programs, and realigned programming for long term inmates.

PSD's implementation of recommended JRI initiatives has not resulted in similar positive outcomes as it pertains to our pre-trial detainee population. We continue to work diligently with our partners in the Judiciary on alternatives to extended pre-trial incarceration.

- <u>Emerging Community Policing Needs</u>: The Sheriff Division has been working collaboratively with the State Department of Health, and other government and private agencies, including service providers, to more effectively respond to those with mental health issues as well the residentially challenged. State law enforcement presence in support of multiple efforts has emerged as an ongoing need, in addition to available law enforcement protection of areas of state jurisdiction and property.
- Oahu Community Correctional Center (OCCC) Replacement: The urgent need for the replacement and relocation of the current OCCC remains a top priority for PSD. PSD, in partnership with Department of Accounting and General Services (DAGS), received approval for the Plan Review Use (PRU) from the Honolulu City Council on February 2020 to move forward with site work on the Halawa Animal Quarantine Site as the home of the new OCCC.
- Department of Justice (DOJ) Settlement Agreement on American With Disability Act (ADA) Deficiencies: The Department is working closely with the Department of the Attorney General to address deficiencies cited by the DOJ at several facilities. An agreement was signed last year, and we have been working diligently on compliance.

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FEDERAL FUNDS

The Department does not foresee any reduction in our federal funded programs and projects at the present time.

BUDGET REQUESTS

The Department's operating budget submittal for FB 2021-23 requests additional funds totaling \$12,833,660 for FY 2021-22 and \$12,157,438 for FY2022-23, the addition of 1.0 Special Funded position, and the deletion of 2.00 Permanent Positions for all means of funding (see Table 6).

Our requests centers on funding the 298.50 essential Corrections, Law Enforcement and Administrative positions that were unfunded. Funding for these unfunded positions is critical because of the challenges in the activities described above, including responses to COVID-19 in all our correctional facilities. Adult Corrections Officer (ACO) positions are necessary to safely operate our correctional institutions especially during this pandemic. Law enforcement officers are needed to assist with Safe Travels and the distribution of vaccines. Health Care Division staff are at the forefront of the Department's response to COVID-19 pandemic, which requires all health care disciplines to provide health care service, assistance, and monitoring capabilities in-house at all correctional institutions.

The details of the unfunded positions are listed in the attached excel spreadsheet.

Additionally, in line with the statewide Program Review, the Department submits a total reduction of \$3,974,034 in FY 2021-22 and \$4,635,677 in FY 2022-23 and the deletion of 38.0 positions (see Table 5). The significant reductions in FB2021-23 are as follows:

- \$1,485,629 and 18.0 ACO positions for the delay in the opening of the Ho'okipa Cottage under PSD 409- WCCC
- o \$504,540 and 15.0 Security Officer positions under PSD 503- Sheriffs
- \$181,850 budget reduction for motor vehicle replacement for PSD 503- Sheriffs
- \$1,630,475 reduction in Other Current Expenses from various programs
- \$171,540 and 5.0 positions from PSD 402- Halawa Correctional Facility (2.0), PSD 404- Waiawa Correctional Facility (1.0), and PSD 503- Sheriffs (2.0)

As detailed in Table 3, in total, the Department requests the following for FB2021-23:

FY 2022:	2,743.60 Permanent Positions and 46.00 Temporary Positions \$300,204,917 for all means of funding
FY 2023:	2,743.60 Permanent Positions and 46.00 Temporary Positions \$298,867,052 for all means of funding

The Department's capital improvement program (CIP) requests the lapsing of \$12,968,000 and additional CIP funds of \$88.968 million for FY 2021-22 and \$10,000,000 in FY2022-23 (See Table 15). We highlight the following requests in FY 2021-22 that are construction ready projects:

- 1. \$12.9M Construction cost for the HCCC and MCCC housing projects
- 2. \$35M Construction cost for the Halawa Correctional Facility Consolidated Health Care Unit
- 3. \$20M Lump Sum CIP Projects statewide

We look forward to working closely with your Committees in this 2021 Legislative Session.

<u>OVERVIEW</u>

The Hawaii Paroling Authority (HPA) is a quasi-judicial body (PSD 611 – Determinations (HPA-D)), which is attached to the Department of Public Safety (Department) for administrative purposes only. The mission of the HPA is to serve as the central paroling authority for the State of Hawaii and is responsible for the administration of and discharge of all parole and community supervision programs within the HPA's jurisdiction. The HPA determines appropriate minimum term(s) of imprisonment; whether an eligible individual is in-fact ready for release on parole; and, whether to revoke or suspend parole and recommit parole violators to prison. In addition, the HPA can at its discretion can grant early discharges to persons released on parole providing specific criterion has been met by the paroled person.

Under the general direction and guidance of the Chairman, the parole division (PSD 612 – Supervision and Counseling (HPA SC)), directs and maintains the operational work units of the HPA and provides supervision to persons granted parole so as to assure their behavior conforms to established standards, and to provide guidance, counseling and assistance as may be required to aid their successful reintegration back into the community and rehabilitation.

The HPA's operating budget request for FB2021-23 is as follows:

Overall Total Annual Budget: \$5,081,774

Justice Reinvestment Initiative (ACT 139)

The Council on State Governments (CSG) has been assisting the HPA and other State agencies with the implementation of ACT 139 (Justice Reinvestment Initiative (JRI)), to include the development of goals and objectives, development and implementation of various performance measures to assist agencies and their respective leadership to determine how the initiative is progressing. The JRI is currently on-going. The HPA has compiled data and provided it to the CSG pertaining to the implementation of the provisions of Section 7 (HRS §353-66) of ACT 139 with respect to the 6-month maximum parole revocation period for "first-time" parole violators.

The following are highlights of HPA's activities:

1. In addition to the cooperative agreement HPA entered into with the Department to consider the re-parole of first-time technical parole violators after 90 - 150 days of incarceration as well as the review of cases supported by the Department for early parole consideration, the HPA has implemented the provisions of ACT 139.

In order to reduce recidivism among this population of parolees, the HPA requires inmates to complete all Department RAD recommended programs such as KASHBOX and/or other institutional programs designed to assist them with their effort to remain crime free. This includes recommending mental health treatment and/or dual diagnosis treatment when appropriate. In addition, depending on the nature of the parole violation, the HPA may require parolees to complete residential drug treatment and/or participation in programs in the community as a condition of re-parole.

- 2. The Authority works cooperatively with the Department in reviewing inmate cases and providing administrative reviews if they are within 7 to 12 months of their Tentative Parole Date. This action does not guarantee a release on parole.
- 3. The Authority now generally schedules minimum sentence hearings within three to four months after sentencing by the courts versus the prior practice of five to six months. This has expedited the reclassification of inmates to move minimum custody inmates out of higher security prison beds to more appropriate levels of custody, which in turn reduces the costs of incarceration.
- 4. The Authority now schedules parole and minimum hearings to accommodate inmate transfers between facilities and to eliminate costly movement of inmates to hearings. The hearings are held at all correctional facilities statewide, including Kulani Correctional Facility that began earlier this year.
- 5. Although the HPA is a relatively small agency with only 68 positions statewide (64 Full-Time and 4 Part-Time), the impact the HPA has on the overall criminal justice system and the lives of offenders is significant. As an example, during FY 2020 (July 1, 2019 to June 30, 2020), the HPA conducted 1,317 minimum term hearings for 429 offenders, held 2,582 parole consideration hearings, and conducted 394 parole violation hearing. This is in addition to conducting administrative hearings

and reviews on 472 matters regarding reduction of minimum terms of imprisonment, parole suspensions, discharge consideration, and pardon applications.

- 6. Parole violation hearings are now routinely scheduled approximately 35-45 days after the retake on a warrant of arrest. This has reduced the number of violators "pending hearing" and being held in higher security prison beds. In the case of first time parole violators who qualify under the provisions of ACT 139, parole consideration hearings are usually scheduled to take place within four (4) to five (5) months after the violator's return to custody.
- 7. The Authority reviews individual cases of sentenced felons with immigration detainers. The Authority works closely with the Immigration, Customs, and Enforcement (ICE) staff of the Department of Homeland Security to review all inmates who are subject to deportation. When appropriate, inmates are paroled to Federal custody for immediate deportation to their countries of origin.
- 8. The authority also saw a notable increase in 2020 in the number of offenders requiring sex offender determination hearings.

FEDERAL FUNDS

At this time, the HPA does not have any federal grants, but we consistently apply for federal funding when available, and ensure that state funding will not be affected should HPA receive federal funding that is later discontinued.

BUDGET REQUEST

The Hawaii Paroling Authority is requesting to fund 9.0 unfunded positions in order to continue its mission.

The following are the parameters used to determine the budget priorities of HPA:

- 1. The overall mission of public safety is reinforced if, prior to parole, the inmate has met all their identified programming needs, maintained good institutional conduct, has a low risk of recidivism, and has a good support system.
- 2. The HPA must ensure that all inmates are reconsidered for parole every 12 months after their initial parole denial. This measure relates to the proper treatment of inmates and ensures that statutory requirements are being followed. To ensure statutory requirements are met, the HPA normally schedules reconsideration hearings 11 months following the initial denial of parole and have begun to schedule hearing earlier when warranted.
- 3. The overall measure of public safety is reinforced when a parolee is granted a final discharge because the parolee must have met the criteria set for discharge; i.e., at least five consecutive years of success on parole, no new crimes, and good stability factors (family, residence, and/or employment), or the expiration of maximum sentence. The HPA routinely considers parolees for early discharge prior to five consecutive years of success on parole for

those that have demonstrated above average successful reintegration back into the community (i.e., two to three consecutive years of success on parole, no new crimes, and excellent stability factors (family, residence, and/or employment)).

4. The number of inmates that go beyond their expiration of minimum sentence generally indicates not having met their correctional programming, having poor conduct records in prison, having inadequate parole plans, and/or being deemed a high risk to re-offend.

The HPA is committed to continue to work with the Department in achieving the JRI goals and objectives within the resources available to us. We look forward to working with your committee this 2021 Legislative Session.

Chair Luke, Vice Chair Cullen, and Members of the Committee on Finance:

OVERVIEW

The Hawai'i State Legislature established the Crime Victim Compensation Commission in 1967 (Hawai'i Revised Statutes (HRS), section 351) as a safety net for violent crime victims. Throughout its 53-year history, the Commission has assisted over 30,000 violent crime victims by paying over \$31,000,000.00 in medical costs, counseling costs, lost wages, and funeral expenses not covered by other sources. Many victims would not be able to receive rehabilitation services, counseling services, or bury a loved one without compensation awarded by the Commission.

The Commission plays a leadership role in helping the state and counties plan for and respond to incidents of mass violence and terrorism. After a mass violence or terrorism incident, the Commission serves as the primary funding conduit for federal funds earmarked to address victims' short- and long-term needs. The Commission recognized the absence of mass violence response in early versions of the State's emergency plan and its failure to include the victim services component in its planning. In response, the Commission took the lead to establish partnerships, develop emergency protocols, and provide training opportunities that acknowledge victim services and the need to collaborate, train, plan, and prepare for mass violence incidents.

The Commission began its Restitution Recovery Project in 2003 to collect court-ordered restitution payments and certain fees from inmates and parolees and to disburse those funds to their crime victims. The payments collected from inmates and parolees are deposited into a Trust account and then disbursed to the payee per the court order. In 2011, the Restitution Recovery Project became a part of the Justice Reinvestment Act continuing its role.

FUNDING SHORTFALL

Hawaii's Crime Victim Compensation program will cease to operate next year without an emergency infusion of funds. The Commission respectfully and urgently requests your support of the Commission's budget request of \$676,222.00.

The Compensation Fee was created by the legislature to act as the primary source of funding for the Commission. No State general funds have been appropriated for victim compensation since FY 2003, and the Commission is now funded solely from non-tax revenue and matching federal Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) funds.

Concerns about Compensation Fee revenue shortfalls brought about by judges failing to order the Compensation Fee in all eligible cases and the resulting negative impact on the financial stability of the Commission have been the subject of the Commission's budget testimony and annual report every year. As we reported in the Commission's FY 2019 annual report the Judiciary collected only \$666,295.23 in compensation fees during FY 2019 - the lowest annual collection since FY 2001. Compensation Fee collection during FY 2020 fell even lower to \$509,822.67. Compensation Fee collection shortfalls over these many years have effectively deprived the Commission of the funding reserve it needs to survive the pandemic. In addition, the current pandemic-related court closures have so limited the Commission's Compensation Fee revenue that the Commission's compensation program is in danger of closing in 2021.

Without sufficient revenue, the safety net the Commission has been able to provide to victims of violent crime will come to an end. The Commission has already done everything possible to reduce its expenses to the bone. Only half of the eight (8) compensation positions are currently filled. Benefits for crime victims and their survivors have been limited and reduced. Victims with catastrophic medical expenses are now only eligible for a maximum of \$14,000 to pay their medical bills, instead of the \$20,000 allowed under the statute. The Commission has, for some time, routinely asked medical providers to accept reduced payments from the Commission as payments in full for that provider's services.

The Commission is currently working with the Judiciary to address compensation fee collection shortfalls and is confident that with our collaborative efforts, we will be able to improve compensation fee collections.

FEDERAL FUNDS

Every year, the Commission receives a sixty percent (60%) federal matching grant award for every State dollar expended to compensate victims of violent crime from the US Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Office for Victims of Crime, through the Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) of 1984. While the Commission is not currently at risk of losing federal funds, because

this is a federal matching grant, if the Commission has no state funds to pay compensation, there can be no matching federal funds.

BUDGET REQUEST

The Commission's budget is developed by reviewing prior years' compensation award data to determine compensation payouts together with fixed monthly and annual payroll and operating expenses. The Commission then looks at the anticipated expenses against the revenue generated from non-tax revenue.

Failure of the Judiciary to assess and collect the compensation fee in all eligible cases over these many years has deprived the Commission of the funding reserve needed to survive the pandemic. Additionally, funding from the compensation fee has been significantly impaired as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic which has substantially depleted the Commission's funding base.

The Commission is requesting a one-time cash infusion of \$676,222.00 for fiscal year 2022 to cover payroll expenses of \$276,222.00 and operating/compensation awards expenses of \$400,000.00 while the Commission works with the Judiciary to increase orders and collection of the compensation fee. Without the assistance of this cash infusion, the Commission will no longer exist and the safety net that the Commission provides to victims of violent crime will vanish and Hawai'i will be the only state that does not have a compensation program to assist victims of violent crime.
