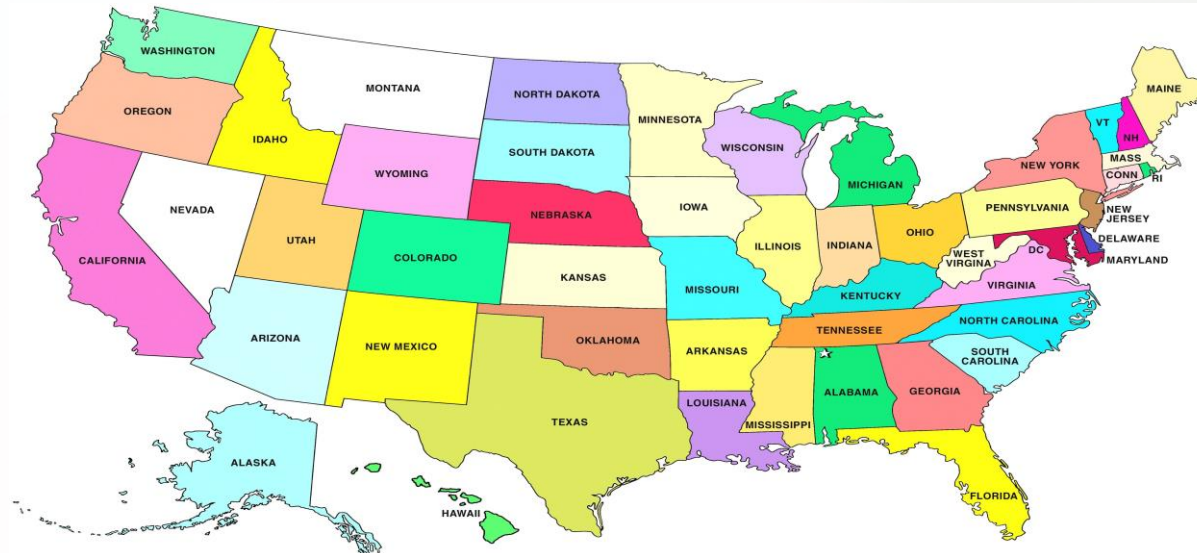


DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS AND REHABILITATION

Hawaii's Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (DCR) is a **unified** correctional system whereby all State jails and prisons are owned and operated by the State.

Hawaii is one of only six other unified correctional jurisdictions in the country:

1. Alaska
2. Connecticut
3. Delaware
4. **Hawaii**
5. Rhode Island
6. Vermont



In the remaining 44 States, Counties own and operate jails, and the State owns and operate prisons.

DCR Consists of 3 Major Divisions

2. Correctional Institutions (Approximately 1,901.40 Positions)



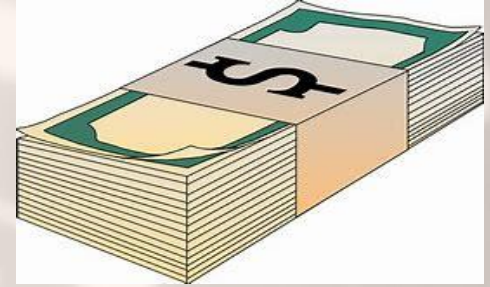
3. Rehabilitation Services and Programs (Approximately 530.60 Positions)
