Dear Honorable Judge Foley and Commission Members,

Thank you for the opportunity to provide testimony. I fully support the below 5 critical campaign finance reform related measures proposed by Gary Hooser.

1. Only allow public funding for all State and County elections in Hawai'i.

2. Prohibit the solicitation or acceptance of campaign donations during the legislative session.

3. Reduce the cap on campaign donations from from \$6,000, \$4,000 and \$2,000 to \$100, \$100, and \$100.

4. Prohibit contributions from corporations and unions as 21 other states now do.

5. Limit candidate campaign funds ("war chests").

In addition, especially in election years:

1. Require more frequent reporting of campaign contributions.

2. Require candidates to disclose any direct business or familial relationship to donors.

3. As noted in my June 1 earlier testimony, lobbyists should disclose the specific bills they lobby for/against so the public can compare lobbyist contributions to their campaign donations.

Separately, I support Commissioner Mason's suggestion at the June 15 meeting to please add a discussion of the Initiative-Referendum process as a future agenda item. I am happy to connect the Commission with colleagues with national expertise on this issue, if helpful.
