Department of Land and Natural Resources

The Commission to improve Standards of Conduct has taken on the broad responsibility of addressing serious breaches of duty by legislators and public servants. This includes looking at several bills vetoed by the governor that are meant to ensure transparency in government operations. The Department Land and Natural Resources (Department) offers comments and notes that it had opposed the bills in the last session.

First, the Department would like to note that it is not against transparency. The Department notes that despite all good intentions, a requirement of detailed written minutes will decrease transparency, unless additional staffing is provided. The reality of minutes within the Department of Land and Natural Resources is that the department was at least half a year behind in writing minutes in 2017. The department was able to catch up briefly by assigning additional people to assist with the minutes, but this took staff away from their own job duties, and could not be maintained in perpetuity. The department has frequent, complex, and lengthy meetings which take a very long time to render as detailed minutes. A recording or videotape is a much better record. The department's position on recording meetings is:

1) Support annotated summaries to accompany recorded tor videotaped meetings. We have attached a sample of the Department's annotated summaries, which contain a brief summary of the topic and any discussion of note, a record of the vote, and the time stamp for recording, which is posted on the Department's website.

At the last meeting, the Commission took up the public records bill. However, we would like to submit late testimony. The department is on record as opposing the total fee waiver for requests in the public interest, due to concerns about potential increases in the volume of documents

requested. The Commission report noted the Department's comments and we hope they were taken into consideration. We are available for questions.
