Quorum was established with nine members present. Also present in-person were current legislative staffers Christine Kubota, Jessie Faige, and Taylor Sayles, and incoming legislative staffer Morgan Lee; Rosemarie Bernardo at the Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation; Institutions Division Administrator Michael Hoffman; HCF Warden Shannon Cluney; and HCF Deputy Warden Lyle Antonio.

- **Written Testimony:** No previously submitted written testimony was received.

The tour opened with a presentation by HCF leadership, followed by a Question and Answer session with RHG members. Warden Antonio took the group to the facility's restrictive housing areas, often called the SHU (Special Housing Unit) where he opened a cell and showering area for participants to enter. The group also visited the medical unit, which includes exam rooms, medication distribution areas, and spaces for mental health services. The tour also included a stop at a general population residential area and a drive around the perimeter of the building to see the new security fences that had been installed.
