Dear Senators:

I am in receipt of your letter dated May 13, 2020, regarding "Enforcement of the Quarantine and Reopening of the Economy. Please see my response below:

- The documentation provided by the airlines on communicating the quarantine requirements;

Please see the attached communications from Sean Williams, A4A.

- Share the language used by Alaska Airlines on quarantine with other airlines and provide a copy of transmittal to these other airlines;

Please the attached letter to A4A.

- Amend the airport forms to capture specific data (e.g. URLs) on how each passenger rented accommodations and cars and provide a copy of the newly amended form; and

Please see the attached Mandatory Travel Declaration Form.

- Work with the Hawaii Tourism Authority to communicate to the public exactly what actions are being taken to enforce the quarantine such as identifying and quarantining infected passengers or returning those passengers who do not have proper accommodations.

The passenger verification process and enforcement requires coordination from numerous agencies working together for the benefit of the community. The HDOT public affairs office works with the HTA, Governor's office, DOH and the JIC professionals on a daily basis regarding communication issues. HDOT and the JIC's Daily News Digest have addressed the many topics associated with COVID-19. Tim Sakahara has conducted numerous media interviews with local and international media and he has spoken at Governor Ige's news conferences to inform the public. HDOT will continue collaborating with HTA and the other communications teams to effectively update the public in a timely manner.
