WILDFIRE PREVENTION

To identify the causes of wildfires and preventative action that may be taken to reduce the risk of wildfires throughout the state, and prepare recommendations for appropriate legislative action.



In response to the Maui Wildfires, the State House of Representatives created 6 interim working groups to address various aspects of the long-term response. Representative Chun was appointed to two of these groups, including the Wildfire Prevention working group, which has a significate disaster preparedness component to it.
