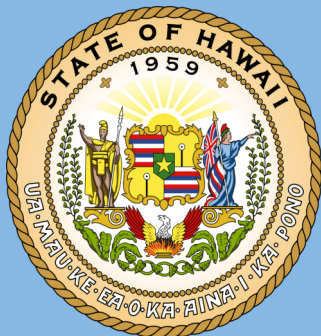

The Hawai'i State Legislature is in its final weeks of the 2024 Legislative Session. This is conference committee time where the final details of bills are negotiated between the House and Senate.

Despite the late stages of session, I was able to work with neighboring Representative Rachele Lamosao to draft a request to the City and County of Honolulu by amending House Resolution 77, urging them to reconsider the Waipio Soccer Complex as its next Landfill.

While we understand that no one wants to have a landfill in their community, Representative Lamosao and I thought this was an important step for us to take in looking after the people we represent and are happy that, despite a few concerns over the lack of viable options, HR77 was adopted in final form by the full House.
