Dear Neighbors,

The 2026 legislative session is in full swing, which means I'm back on O'ahu full time. As Chair of the Housing Committee, my top priority is doing everything I can to bring down the cost of housing and expand opportunities for local families to stay in Hawai'i.

This year I introduced 35 bills—nearly all focused on addressing the housing crisis. Highlights include measures to:

- Reduce barriers to building multi-family housing
- Create a dedicated annual funding source to invest in infrastructure and support the Department of Hawaiian Home Lands
- Modernize rules to make manufactured housing easier to deliver
- Reduce barriers for smaller starter homes
- Increase funding for affordable and mixed-income workforce housing

While housing is my main focus, I also serve on the Transportation, Education, and Higher Education committees. I'm working to reduce congestion, make it easier and safer to walk, bike, and take the bus, and support our public schools and the University of Hawai'i so every student has access to a high-quality education.

If you have questions about any bills, want to engage in the legislative process, or need help navigating state services, my office is here to help. And if you're ever on O'ahu during session, we'd love to have you visit us at the State Capitol.
