GOVERNOR RELEASES FUNDS FOR NEW COMMUNITY RECREATIONAL PAVILION

HONOLULU – Governor David Ige today released \$200,000 in construction funds to the Innovations Public Charter School Foundation for the construction of a new community recreational pavilion on the Island of Hawaii.

"This recreational center will provide another much-needed gathering space for all of West Hawai'i," said Senator Dru Mamo Kanuha, whose district includes the charter school. "This achievement is indicative of the hard work done at the local and state level, ensuring quality resources and facilities in the community."

Governor Ige also recognized Sen. Kanuha's efforts. "Mahalo for your work on behalf of the residents of your district to secure these funds," said the Governor in his announcement of the release of funds.
