


NEW DISTRICTING IN EFFECT

The 14th Senatorial District comprises the portion of the island of Oahu including Kalihi, a portion of Fort Shafter, and Moanalua. The new district lines now include more of the community.



Every 10 years following the census, the distribution of the population is reviewed to redraw the political districts to ensure that citizens are equally represented. Reapportionment ensures each political district has been created equally using census data.
