The Committee asks that you provide data on the projected DOE PPE needs through the end of the school year. Please deliver a breakout of these projections by complex area and school, as well as the metrics used for these projections.

Additionally, the Committee requests that you provide an accounting of all PPE supplied to each school to date, as well as an outline of your plans for the collection, storage, and distribution of PPE to schools moving forward.

Finally, as you highlighted your current discussions with the Department of Health pertaining to the development of triggers and procedures for the closures of schools in the event of a rise in infection, the Committee asks that you provide these triggers and procedures.
