TRAFFIC UPDATE - Farrington Highway

Week of Oct. 20, 2013

Daytime Activities:

- Maintenance crews will work along sections of Farrington Highway in Waipahu from 8:30 a.m.-3 p.m. During the work, Kiewit vehicles may be temporarily parked in the highway lanes, causing a slight slowdown in the traffic flow.
- There will be east and westbound lane closure of the inside and outside lanes along Farrington Highway between:
 - Kahualii Street and Waiawa Road

Evening Activities:

- Crews will be locating existing utilities along Farrington Highway in Waipahu from the hours of 7 p.m.-6 a.m. There will be east and westbound lane closures of the inside and outside lanes along Farrington Highway between:
 - Old Fort Weaver Road and Mokuola Street
 - One lane in each direction of Farrington Highway will remain open at all times

Road Closures:

There will be a full closure of the west-bound lanes of Old Farrington Highway between Kualakai Parkway (North-South Road) and Old Fort Weaver Road Loop 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

- Traffic in the west-bound direction of Old Farrington Highway will be detoured to either the H-1 Freeway or other nearby roadways.
- Drivers will be able to access the Farrington Highway in Ewa from the east-bound direction, and will be detoured onto the Old Fort Weaver Road intersection near the Kahi Mohala Behavioral Center.

Shoulder and median work signage/cones along the side of the road will mark the work area. Motorists are advised to drive with caution and provide a safe distance between themselves, the construction workers and vehicles.
