 - 1. Behind (or will be soon) on rent or utilities, or are at risk of homelessness; and

 - 3. Have income less than 50% of median income (depends on family size but \$63,000/year for family of 4). **Once that group is served, applications will be open for those who have 80% of median income (depends on family size but \$101,000/year for family of 4).
- Benefits for up to 12 months. Can be paid in lump sum if you already owe 12 months.
