

## Senate Budget Prioritizes Programs and Projects for Mililani and Wahiawa

The State Budget articulates the Legislature's priorities because funding means commitment and investment. The Senate's Draft clearly shows that the Senate is committed to delivering key projects and programs into our districts, where they will make the most impact.

Senate District 17 includes Mililani Town, Mililani Mauka, Waipio Acres, Launani Valley, Wahiawa, and Whitmore Village. My previous newsletter provided highlights on statewide initiatives that will benefit all Hawaii residents. The highlights have a direct impact on Senate District 17.

Notable Programs and Projects for Mililani:

- \$10.5 million for a new covered playcourt at Mililani High School
- \$5 million for a new building for the Department of Law Enforcement in Mililani Tech Park
- \$12 million for a new HIEMA operations center in Mililani Tech Park
- \$50 million for infrastructure improvement for the First Responders Technology Campus
- \$3.5 million to improve the Mililani High School softball field

Notable Programs and Projects for Wahiawa:

- \$18 million for an admin building at Leilehua High School
- \$2 million to improve Hugh Yoshida Stadium
- \$15 million for building renovations at Wheeler Elementary and Middle Schools
- \$26 million to purchase and improve the Wahiawa Irrigation System
- \$1 million for a DOCARE sub-station
- \$200,000 to support the cybersecurity academy at Leilehua High School
- \$1.2 million for the Judiciary at the Wahiawa Civic Center
