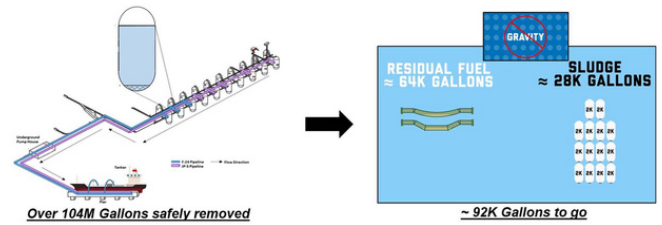

RED HILL FUEL TANKS DEFUELING NEAR COMPLETION, AHEAD OF SCHEDULE



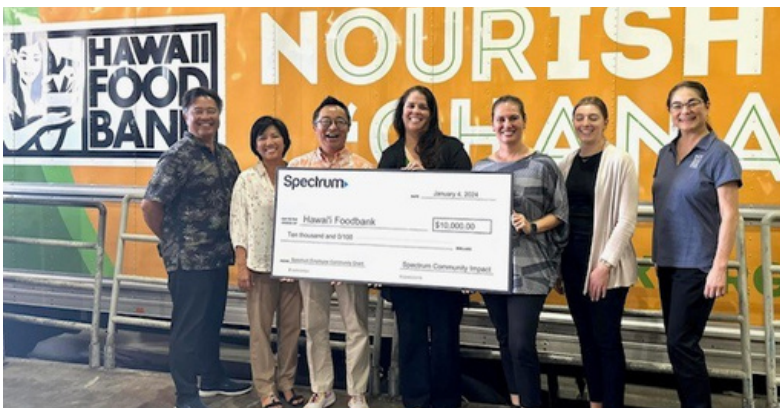
Fuel Remaining Following Gravity Defueling

The Navy successfully drained 99.9% of the 104 million gallons of jet fuel in their Red Hill tanks. They updated the Senate’s Public Safety and Military Affairs Committee on January 8, and said not one drop got into the aquifer. They will eventually turn the project over to the Navy Closure Task Force-Red Hill, which will continue working towards the shared mission to ensure safety, security, and community engagement. In the coming months, work begins to remove approximately 60,000 of the 92,000 remaining gallons of residual fuel.
