A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO WAIVER OF ABANDONED VEHICLE PUBLIC AUCTION
REQUIREMENTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 290-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "§290-5 Waiver of public auction requirements. The
4 requirements of public auction may be waived when the value of
5 any vehicle is less than \$1,000 as determined by the director of
6 finance or authorized representative[-] or the vehicle is:

7 (1) Missing major components or so materially damaged as
8 to render the vehicle inoperable; and

9 (2) The registration period has expired for the vehicle.

10 In that event, the vehicle, after public advertisement has been
11 made pursuant to section 1-28.5, may be disposed of in the same
12 manner as when a vehicle is put up for public auction and for
13 which no bid is received."


14 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
