**A BILL FOR AN ACT**

RELATING TO HOLIDAYS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended  
2 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to  
3 read as follows:

4 "S8- Peace day. September 21 of each year shall be  
5 known and recognized as "Peace Day" to promote peace programs,  
6 improve international relations, and increase educational  
7 awareness of peace; provided that this day is not and shall not  
8 be construed to be a state holiday. All citizens shall be  
9 encouraged to observe and celebrate the blessings of peace and  
10 endeavor to create peace on peace day."

11 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
