14 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
 15 of transportation, highways division, for the purposes of this
 16 Act.

17 SECTION 4. The sums hereinabove may be paid to the
 18 respective persons, or for the satisfaction or settlement of the
 19 respectively identified cases, and in several amounts
 20 hereinabove set forth or in lesser amounts deemed appropriate,
 21 upon checks issued by the comptroller; provided departments must
 22 obtain the approval of the attorney general before payment of
 23 any claim can be made.

24 SECTION 5. Notwithstanding the sums hereinabove stated as
 25 interest upon judgments against the State, payment of interest
 26 shall be limited to the period from the date of judgment, if
 27 applicable, to thirty days after the effective date of this
 28 part, as provided in section 662-8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, for
 29 those cases to which the statute applies.



1 PART IV

2 SECTION 6. All unexpended and unencumbered balances of the
3 appropriations made in this Act as of the close of business on
4 June 30, 2008, shall lapse.

5 SECTION 7. If any provision of this Act, or the
6 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held
7 invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or
8 applications of the Act, which can be given effect without the
9 invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions
10 of this Act are severable.

11 SECTION 8. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
