H. B. 2152, H.D. 2 RELATING TO TRAFFIC VIOLATIONS

Senate Committee on Transportation

The Department of Transportation (DOT) **supports** H.B 2152, H.D. 2 which requires additional circumstances under which every vehicle, including motor vehicles, motorcycles, motor scooters, and motorized bicycles, moving on any public highway in the State must display its lighted head lamps.

Between 2015-2019, there were 545 motor vehicle fatalities on our roadways. We can and need to do more to reduce the number of fatalities to zero.

As such, the DOT supports all efforts to improve traffic safety and reduce the number of senseless deaths and injuries on our roadways.
