# **Department's Position:**

The Hawaii State Department of Education (Department) is providing comments on HCR 193.

The Department believes that the safety of its students is of utmost importance to helping youth learn and thrive. However, conducting a study on expanding the jurisdictional boundaries for each school would be challenging for the Department to accomplish at this time. This would overextend our schools' limited staffing and financial resources.

Hawaii case law (Miller v Yoshimoto, 56 Haw. 333, 1975), stipulates that the Department has a duty to provide reasonable supervision of its students during their required presence at school and immediately after the school day is over. This duty entails general supervision unless specific needs or a dangerous or likely to be dangerous situation calls for specific supervision.
