The purpose of this measure is to authorize pharmacists to administer human papillomavirus, Tdap (tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis), meningococcal, and influenza vaccines to eleventhrough seventeen-year-old patients pursuant to a valid prescription.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from the Department of Health, Board of Pharmacy, University of Hawaii Hilo Daniel K. Inouye College of Pharmacy, Planned Parenthood Votes Northwest and Hawaii, American Congress of Obstetricians and Gynecologists, The CHOW Project, Hawaii Public Health Institute, Hawaii Medical Service Association, Weinstein Pharmacy, CVS Health, Walgreen Co., Times Pharmacy, American Cancer Society Cancer Action Network, Hawaii Youth Services Network, and numerous individuals. Your Committee received testimony in opposition to this measure from a few individuals. Hawaii Pharmacists Association and an individual submitted comments.
