Your Committees on Water, Land, & Hawaiian Affairs and Tourism & International Affairs, to which was referred S.B. No. 504, S.D. 2, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO IOLANI PALACE,"

beg leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to appropriate funds for the repair, restoration, and maintenance of the coronation pavilion, two pergolas, and fountain on the grounds of Iolani Palace.

Your Committees received testimony in support of this measure from the Department of Land and Natural Resources and Historic Hawai'i Foundation.

Your Committees have amended this measure by:

- Specifying that the funds appropriated may also be used for measures to mitigate the threat of fire to Iolani Palace's collection of artifacts; and
- (2) Changing its effective date to July 1, 2049.
