RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 286-47, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 amended to read as follows:

3 "§286-47 Certificate of registration; certificate of
4 ownership; containers. (a) Upon the registration of a vehicle,
5 the director of finance shall issue a certificate of
6 registration to the owner and a certificate of ownership to the
7 legal owner, or to a dealer who shall be a person licensed to
8 sell new motor vehicles under chapter 437 which certificates
9 shall meet the following requirements:

10 Both the certificate of registration and the (1)11 certificate of ownership shall contain upon the face 12 thereof, the date issued, the registration number 13 assigned to the owner and to the vehicle, the name and 14 address of the owner and legal owner in typewriting, 15 also such description of the registered vehicle as may 16 be determined by the director of finance. If any of 17 the information subsequently proves to be a

typographical error, the dealer, as defined in section 1 2 437-1.1, shall notify the director of finance of the 3 error by a written certificate stating the reasons for 4 and nature of the error and the correction which 5 should be made in the certificate of registration and the certificate of ownership. Upon receipt of the 6 dealer's certificate by the director of finance, the 7 8 certificate of registration and the certificate of 9 ownership shall be corrected accordingly so long as 10 the correction does not constitute a change of the vehicle originally registered. A fee shall be paid to 11 12 the director of finance for each instance of correction of the registration records. The fee 13 charged for each instance of correction of the 14 registration records shall be established by the 15 16 county's legislative body; 17 (2)In addition to the requirements provided for in paragraph (1) above, the face of the certificate of 18 19 ownership shall contain endorsement lines for the transfer of title or interest of the registered owner 20 21 and legal owner, and the odometer reading of the

1 vehicle on the date of transfer. The reverse side of 2 the certificate of ownership shall contain the 3 application for registration by the transferee [+]. 4 [(3)(A)] (b) Every owner shall keep the certificate of 5 registration within the vehicle for which it is registered and shall present the same at the request of a police officer, or in 6 7 the event the vehicle is a motorcycle, shall carry such certificate in a convenient receptacle attached to the vehicle 8 and which shall be presented at the request of a police officer; 9 10 provided that this subsection shall not apply to: [(B)] (1) [This shall not apply to state] State or 11 12 county vehicles readily identified by the license plates and markings on sides of such vehicles; 13 [(C)] (2) [This shall not apply to commercial] 14 Commercial vehicles defined as rental motor vehicles, 15 or cars shipped by licensed car dealerships or 16 17 repossession companies. These businesses may keep a duplicate copy of the certificate of registration 18 19 within the vehicle for which it is registered, in 20 which case the certificate of registration shall be

1	available for inspection at their principal place of
2	business within the State; and
3	(3) Chassis used for transporting shipping containers.
4	These businesses may keep a duplicate copy of the
5	certificate of registration, in which case the
6	original certificate of registration shall be
7	available for inspection at their principal place of
8	business within the State.
9	[(D)] This [requirement to carry the certificate of
10	registration with the vehicle] subsection shall not apply when
11	[such] the certificate is removed from the vehicle for the
12	purpose of application for renewal, transfer of registration, or
13	to record a change in the registration."
14	SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
15	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
16	begun before its effective date.
17	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
18	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
19	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
