BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 269, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "§269- Energy data access and transparency; principles.
- 5 (a) The commission, in carrying out its responsibilities under
- 6 this chapter, shall consider the value of improving energy data
- 7 access and transparency within the State in order to empower
- 8 ratepayers, improve decision-making related to reliability and
- 9 operational efficiency of the electric system, maximize the
- 10 value of grid modernization technologies and investments, and
- 11 promote innovation and economic development opportunities
- 12 related to energy data analysis.
- 13 (b) In advancing the public interest, the commission shall
- 14 balance consumer privacy, critical infrastructure security, grid
- 15 modernization, and economic innovation considerations associated
- 16 with energy data transparency and access, including but not
- 17 limited to the following principles:
