A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CROSSWALKS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 (a) There is established within the department SECTION 1. 2 of transportation (department) a community crosswalks pilot program, which shall design and implement a specially painted 3 4 crosswalk that represents a neighborhood's unique culture and 5 promotes pedestrian safety. The program shall collaborate with the appropriate county departments and agencies, as determined 6 by the director of transportation. 7

8 (b) The department shall designate a crosswalk within the
9 Waipahu school complex area to be used for the pilot program;
10 provided that the crosswalk:

11 (1)Shall be at a location that is already marked with a 12 crosswalk, and where a vehicle is required to stop, 13 either due to a stop sign or traffic signal; To the extent possible, shall be located at an 14 (2)15 intersection with shorter width between streets and 16 that experiences lower traffic volume; and 17 (3) Is located on pavement that is in good condition.



1	(c)	The design of the crosswalk shall comply with the
2	following	guidelines:
3	(1)	The crosswalk design shall include two white
4		horizontal markings with standard design and
5		reflectivity to mark the edges of the crosswalk and
6		ensure that the crosswalk meets minimum standards as
7		required by state and county law;
8	(2)	The crosswalk design shall be fully contained within
9		the two white horizontal markings;
10	(3)	The design shall use only horizontal or vertical
11		stripes to ensure that people driving, walking, and
12		biking are aware that the specially painted crosswalk
13		is an official crosswalk and a designated place for
14		people to cross;
15	(4)	Colors for the crosswalk shall be approved by the
16		department; and
17	(5)	No text or logos, or octagons, triangles, or other
18		symbols shall be used.



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1	(d) Once a design is approved by the department, the
2	department shall work in coordination with the department of
3	transportation services of the city and county of Honolulu to
4	apply the approved design to the designated crosswalk.
5	(e) There is established a community crosswalks special
6	fund to be administered by the department of transportation for
7	the purposes of this section, into which shall be deposited:
8	(1) All moneys appropriated by the legislature;
9	(2) Moneys withdrawn from the safe routes to school
10	program special fund established under section 291C-4,
11	Hawaii Revised Statutes; and
12	(3) Gifts and other private funds.
13	The community crosswalks special fund shall be abolished on
14	June 30, 2021, and all unencumbered balances shall lapse to the
15	credit of the general fund.
16	(f) The department shall submit a report of its
17	activities, including any proposed legislation, to the
18	legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of
19	the regular sessions of 2020 and 2021.

1	SECTION 2. Section 291C-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3	"(a) There is established in the state treasury the safe
4	routes to school program special fund, into which shall be
5	deposited:
6	(1) Assessments collected for speeding in a school zone,
7	pursuant to section 291C-104; and
8	(2) Safe routes to school program surcharges collected in
9	accordance with sections 291-16 and 291C-5.
10	Moneys in the fund shall be:
11	(1) [distributed] Distributed by the director of
12	transportation to the respective counties to
13	expend [-]; and
14	(2) Used for the community crosswalks pilot program
15	established by Act , Session Laws of Hawaii 2019."
16	SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
17	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
18	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020 and the
19	same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
20	2020-2021 for deposit into the community crosswalks pilot
21	program special fund established under section 1 of this Act.



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1 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the safe routes to 2 school program special fund established under section 291C-4, 3 Hawaii Revised Statutes, the sum of \$ or so much thereof 4 as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020 and the same sum 5 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 6 for deposit into the community crosswalks pilot program special 7 fund established under section 1 of this Act. 8 SECTION 5. There is appropriated out of the community 9 crosswalks pilot program special fund the sum of \$ or so 10 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020 and 11 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal 12 year 2020-2021 for the purposes of the community crosswalk pilot 13 program established by section 1 of this Act. 14 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department 15 of transportation for the purposes of this Act. 16 SECTION 6. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 17 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 18 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2019, and 19 shall be repealed on June 30, 2021; provided that section 291C-20 4(a), Hawaii Revised Statutes, shall be reenacted in the form in
