## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MARINE AQUARIUM FISHING.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that kanaka maoli values 2 such as living in harmony and balance with nature, malama 'aina, 3 kuleana for the surrounding environment, the concept of aloha 4 'āina, and other Native Hawaiian traditional and customary 5 gathering rights and cultural practices are the foundation of the constitution of the State of Hawaii's mandates related to 6 7 the conservation and management of natural resources. The 8 commercial aquarium trade is contrary to these native Hawaiian 9 values, traditional and customary gathering rights, and other 10 cultural practices.

11 The purpose of this Act is to prohibit all commercial 12 capture of aquatic life for aquarium purposes, regardless of the 13 method of collection, effective March 1, 2024.

14 This Act is intended to allow the following practices to 15 continue:

16 (1) Issuance of special activity permits pursuant to
17 section 187A-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes;

12	SECTION 2. Chapter 189, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
13	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated	
14	and to read as follows:	
15	" <u>§18</u>	9- Harvesting aquatic life for commercial aquarium
16	purposes; prohibition; definitions. (a) No person shall	
17	harvest aquatic life for commercial aquarium purposes effective	
18	March 1, 2024.	
19	(b)	This section shall not apply to the issuance of a
20	license o	r permit for activities permitted in sections 187A-3.5

3	(c) For the purposes of this section:		
4	"Aquarium purposes" means to hold salt water fish,		
5	freshwater nongame fish, or other aquatic life alive in a state		
6	of captivity as pets, for public exhibition or display, or for		
7	sale for these purposes.		
8	"Aquatic life" means any type or species of mammal, fish,		
9	amphibian, reptile, mollusk, crustacean, arthropod,		
10	invertebrate, coral, or other animal that inhabits the		
11	freshwater or marine environment and includes any part, product,		
12	egg, or offspring thereof; or marine plants, including seeds,		
13	roots, products, and other parts thereof.		
14	"Commercial" means to take aquatic life for profit or gain		
15	or where the aquatic life is sold, offered for sale, possessed		
16	with intent to sell, bartered, landed, or transported for sale.		
17	"Harvest" means the taking and retaining of aquatic life by		
18	any means whatsoever."		
19	SECTION 3. If there is any conflict with section 188-31,		
20	Hawaii Revised Statutes, this Act shall supersede.

If any provision of this Act, or the 2 application thereof to any person or circumstance, is held 3 invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or applications of the Act that can be given effect without the 4 5 invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions 6 of this Act are severable. 7 SECTION 5. New statutory material is underscored. 8 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on March 15, 2094.
