BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. (a) The office of enterprise technology
2	services shall conduct a study to identify appropriate state
3	office buildings able to provide equitable telecommunication
4	access to allow residents and residents with disabilities to
5	remotely participate in legislative hearings for the following
6	areas:
7	(1) The county of Hawaii;
8	(2) The county of Kauai;
9	(3) The county of Maui; and
10	(4) Rural areas in the City and County of Honolulu.
11	(b) The office of enterprise technology services shall
12	submit a report of its findings and recommendations, including
13	any proposed legislation, to the legislature no later than
14	twenty days prior to the convening of the regular session of
15	2022.
16	SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
