A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SUSTAINABLE AGRICULTURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the use of cover
- 2 crops and green manure increases agricultural productivity and
- 3 aligns with the State's integrated sustainability goals. Plants
- 4 used for this purpose, including grasses, legumes, and forbs,
- 5 add nutrients to the soil, act as windbreaks, assist with water
- 6 retention, provide habitats for beneficial insects, and help to
- 7 prevent soil erosion.
- 8 The legislature further finds that it is in the interest of
- 9 the State to incentivize the use of management practices that
- 10 enhance the quality and sustainability of Hawaii's agricultural
- 11 lands.
- 12 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to establish and
- 13 appropriate moneys for a crop reimbursement pilot program to
- 14 reimburse farming operations in the State for the costs of
- 15 acquiring cover crop seeds or green manure.
- 16 SECTION 2. (a) The department of agriculture shall
- 17 establish and implement a three-year crop reimbursement pilot



- 1 program to reimburse farming operations in the State for the
- 2 costs of acquiring cover crop seeds or green manure.
- 3 (b) Applications for cost reimbursements shall be
- 4 submitted on a form furnished by the department of agriculture
- 5 and shall be accompanied by documentation of the costs of
- 6 purchase, pursuant to subsection (c); provided that:
- 7 (1) The applicant shall indemnify and hold harmless the
- 8 State and its officers, agents, and employees from all
- 9 claims arising out of or resulting from the cover crop
- seeds or green manure purchased; and
- 11 (2) The department of agriculture may request that an
- applicant provide additional information for the
- purposes of verifying the volume of cover crop or
- 14 green manure purchased.
- (c) Applications for reimbursement under the crop
- 16 reimbursement pilot program shall be filed for seeds purchased
- 17 within the fiscal year immediately preceding the filing and be
- 18 effective for costs of purchasing cover crops or green manure
- 19 incurred after June 30, 2021, and before July 1, 2024. The
- 20 documentation shall include a certification that the amount for
- 21 which the applicant seeks reimbursement is not already covered



- 1 by other governmental cover crop incentive programs, including
- the National Resource Conservation Service's environmental
- 3 quality incentive payment program or the conservation
- 4 stewardship program.
- 5 (d) Funds shall be dispersed upon approval on an annual
- 6 basis by the department of agriculture to the farmer or rancher
- 7 for up to one hundred per cent of the costs incurred for cover
- 8 crop seeds or green manure purchased after June 30, 2021, and
- 9 before July 1, 2024.
- 10 (e) The department of agriculture shall aggregate the
- 11 total reimbursement applications pursuant to this section and
- 12 divide and distribute the available moneys on a first come,
- 13 first served basis; provided that no farming operation shall
- 14 receive a total reimbursement of more than \$50,000 per year.
- 15 (f) There is established within the department of
- 16 agriculture a cover crop reimbursement pilot program manager
- 17 position, which shall be a full-time temporary position exempt
- 18 from chapters 76 and 89, Hawaii Revised Statutes. The cover
- 19 crop reimbursement pilot program manager shall receive a salary
- 20 not to exceed \$50,000 per year. The cover crop reimbursement
- 21 pilot program manager shall possess a requisite level of

- 1 knowledge and expertise in the area of program management
- 2 necessary to carry out the duties of the position. The cover
- 3 crop pilot reimbursement program manager shall:
- 4 (1) Facilitate the division and distribution of available
- 5 costs for reimbursement; and
- 6 (2) Manage the day-to-day coordination of the cover crop
- 7 reimbursement pilot program.
- 8 (g) Any action taken by the department of agriculture
- 9 pursuant to this section shall be exempt from the rulemaking
- 10 requirements of chapter 91, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 11 (h) The department of agriculture shall submit a report of
- 12 its findings and recommendations, including any proposed
- 13 legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior
- 14 to the convening of the regular session of 2025. The report
- 15 shall include the department's recommendation on whether the
- 16 pilot program should be extended, with or without modifications.
- 17 (i) As used in this section:
- "Cover crop" and "green manure" mean the plants listed in
- 19 the cover crop and green manure database maintained by the
- 20 university of Hawaii college of tropical agriculture and human
- 21 resources.

- 3 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1,000,000 or so much
- 5 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2021-2022 and the
- 6 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 7 2022-2023 for the department of agriculture to establish,
- 8 implement, and administer a cover crop reimbursement pilot
- 9 program; provided that up to \$20,000 may be used for
- 10 administrative costs.
- 11 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 12 agriculture for the purposes of this Act.
- 13 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2021.
