A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE FESTIVAL OF PACIFIC ARTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Act 104, Session
- 2 Laws of Hawaii 2017, created the temporary commission on the
- 3 thirteenth festival of pacific arts to plan the festival of
- 4 pacific arts originally scheduled to be held in Hawaii in June
- 5 2020. Due to the outbreak of the coronavirus disease 2019
- 6 (COVID-19), the Pacific Community, the international custodian
- 7 of the festival, notified the State that it is postponing the
- 8 festival to 2024. Therefore, the temporary commission, which
- 9 was to cease to exist on June 30, 2021, must be extended to
- 10 fulfill its duties to plan the thirteenth festival of pacific
- 11 arts in 2024.
- 12 The legislature further finds that to ensure a successful
- 13 festival, the temporary commission members have had to carry-out
- 14 the responsibilities of planning several components of the
- 15 festival in a hands-on manner, including fundraising,
- 16 communicating with the foreign delegations, scheduling of
- 17 events, organizing volunteers, and securing housing,

- 1 transportation, meals, security, and medical services. To
- 2 carry-out and coordinate these responsibilities, occasionally
- 3 more than a quorum of the commission members must be able to
- 4 communicate expeditiously and outside of the confines of chapter
- 5 92, Hawaii Revised Statutes. At the same time, the legislature
- 6 finds that the commission is committed to fulfilling the policy
- 7 and intent of chapter 92, Hawaii Revised Statutes, including by
- 8 holding regularly-scheduled open meetings and posting notices
- 9 and minutes.
- 10 The purpose of this Act is to:
- 11 (1) Extend the date on which the temporary commission on
- the thirteenth festival of pacific arts ceases to
- exist to August 31, 2025; and
- 14 (2) Permit the commission members to discuss matters
- relating to official board business without regard to
- part I of chapter 92, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to
- enable them to perform their duties faithfully.
- 18 SECTION 2. Act 104, Session Laws of Hawaii 2017, is
- 19 amended by amending section 4 to read as follows:
- 20 "SECTION 4. The commission shall cease to exist on
- 21 [June 30, 2021.] August 31, 2025."

- 2 members of the temporary commission on the thirteenth festival
- 3 of pacific arts shall be permitted to discuss matters relating
- 4 to official board business outside of a properly noticed public
- 5 meeting without regard to part I of chapter 92, Hawaii Revised
- 6 Statutes, in order to enable board members to perform their
- 7 duties faithfully.
- 8 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 9 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 10 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
