## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE FESTIVAL OF PACIFIC ARTS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Act 104, Session
- 2 Laws of Hawaii 2017, created the temporary commission on the
- 3 thirteenth festival of pacific arts to plan the thirteenth
- 4 festival of pacific arts and culture originally scheduled to be
- 5 held in Hawaii in June 2020. Due to the outbreak of the
- 6 coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19), the Pacific Community, the
- 7 international custodian of the festival, notified the State of
- 8 its intent to postpone the festival to 2024. Therefore, the
- 9 temporary commission, which was to cease to exist on June 30,
- 10 2021, must be extended to fulfill its duties to plan the
- 11 thirteenth festival of pacific arts and culture in 2024.
- 12 The legislature further finds that although previous
- 13 festivals have had a contractor to carry out the hands-on
- 14 details of planning a festival, there is currently no contractor
- 15 to fill this role. To ensure a successful festival, the
- 16 commission members themselves have had to carry out the
- 17 responsibilities of planning several components of the festival



- 1 in a hands-on manner, including fundraising, communicating with
- 2 the foreign delegations, scheduling events, organizing
- 3 volunteers, and securing housing, transportation, meals,
- 4 security, and medical services. To carry out and coordinate
- 5 these responsibilities between the scheduled meetings, smaller
- 6 groups of commission members must be able to communicate
- 7 expeditiously and outside of the confines of chapter 92, Hawaii
- 8 Revised Statutes. At the same time, the legislature finds that
- 9 the commission is committed to fulfilling the policy and intent
- 10 of chapter 92, Hawaii Revised Statutes, including by holding
- 11 regularly-scheduled open meetings and posting notices and
- 12 minutes. The commission has been holding its meetings every two
- 13 weeks and is committed to continuing to regularly meet on that
- 14 schedule. Thus, the legislature finds that a permitted
- 15 interaction allowing groups of less than a quorum of commission
- 16 members to work on commission business between its regular
- 17 meetings, while still requiring the commission to hold those
- 18 meetings subject to the Sunshine Law, will balance the public
- 19 interest in access to government decision-making under the
- 20 Sunshine Law with the commission members' need to carry out the
- 21 hands-on portion of running a festival between the regularly

- 1 scheduled meetings at which the commission considers larger
- 2 issues and makes decisions regarding the festival.
- 3 The purpose of this Act is to:
- 4 (1) Extend the date on which the temporary commission on the thirteenth festival of pacific arts shall cease to exist to August 31, 2025; and
- 7 (2) Permit less than a quorum of commission members to
  8 discuss matters relating to official board business
  9 outside a commission meeting as a permitted
  10 interaction under part I of chapter 92, Hawaii Revised
  11 Statutes, to enable them to perform their duties
  12 faithfully; provided that the commission shall hold a
  13 meeting at least once a month.
- 14 SECTION 2. Act 104, Session Laws of Hawaii 2017, is 15 amended by amending section 4 to read as follows:
- "SECTION 4. The commission shall cease to exist on
- 17 [June 30, 2021.] August 31, 2025."
- 18 SECTION 3. Less than a quorum of members of the temporary 19 commission on the thirteenth festival of pacific arts may
- 20 discuss matters relating to official board business outside of a
- 21 properly noticed public meeting in the course of planning the

- 1 festival, and those discussions shall be a permitted interaction
- 2 under section 92-2.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes; provided that the
- 3 commission shall hold a public meeting noticed pursuant to
- 4 part I of chapter 92, Hawaii Revised Statutes, at least once a
- 5 month, at which time it shall report its progress in the matters
- 6 discussed outside a meeting pursuant to this section.
- 7 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 8 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 9 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.

## Report Title:

Festival of Pacific Arts; Temporary Commission

## Description:

Extends the date on which the temporary commission on the thirteenth festival of pacific arts shall cease to exist to August 31, 2025. Permits less than a quorum of commission members to discuss matters relating to official board business outside a commission meeting as a permitted interaction under part I of chapter 92, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to enable them to perform their duties faithfully, provided that the commission holds a properly noticed meeting at least once a month and discusses the progress of the permitted interaction matter at the next meeting. Effective 7/1/2050. (HD1)
