A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII STATE LESBIAN, GAY, BISEXUAL, TRANSGENDER, QUEER, PLUS COMMISSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The Hawaii Revised Statutes is amended by		
adding a new chapter to title 20 to be appropriately designated		
and to read as follows:		
"CHAPTER		
HAWAII STATE LESBIAN, GAY, BISEXUAL, TRANSGENDER, QUEER, PLUS		
COMMISSION		
§ -1 Findings and purpose. The legislature finds that		
there is a need to establish a body to improve the State's		
interface with members of the lesbian, gay, bisexual,		
transgender, queer, plus community; identify the short- and		
long-range needs of its members; and ensure that there is an		
effective means of researching, planning, and advocating for the		
equity of this population in all aspects of state government.		
Accordingly, the purpose of this chapter is to establish a		
commission to provide for a statewide program, on a permanent

- 3 S -2 Definitions. For purposes of this chapter:
- 4 "Commission" means the Hawaii state lesbian, gay, bisexual,
- 5 transgender, queer, plus commission.
- 6 "Lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer, plus" includes
- 7 any individual who identifies as a member of the lesbian, gay,
- 8 bisexual, transgender, or queer community, or any individual who
- 9 identifies as a member of a sexual or gender minority, including
- 10 intersex, asexual, or pansexual individuals.
- 11 § -3 Hawaii state lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender,
- 12 queer, plus commission; membership. (a) There is established
- 13 the Hawaii state lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer,
- 14 plus commission within the department of human services for
- 15 administrative purposes.
- 16 (b) The commission shall consist of the following:
- 17 (1) Six ex officio, nonvoting members or their designees,
- including the:
- 19 (A) Superintendent of education;
- 20 (B) President of the University of Hawaii system;
- 21 (C) Director of labor and industrial relations;

2		(E) Director of human services; and
3		(F) Director of health; and
4	(2)	Eight voting members who shall be appointed by the
5		governor in accordance with section 26-34; provided
6		that of these eight members:
7		(A) One member shall be from the county of Hawaii;
8		(B) One member shall be from the county of Kauai;
9		(C) One member shall be from the county of Maui;
10		(D) Four members shall be from the city and county of
11		Honolulu; and
12		(E) One member shall represent the Hawaii sexual and
13		gender minority workgroup of the department of
14		health.
15	(c)	The governor shall appoint members of the commission:
16	(1)	On the basis of their interest and knowledge in, and
17		their ability to make contributions to, the solution
18		of problems relating to the status of the lesbian,
19		gay, bisexual, transgender, queer, plus community; and
20	(2)	That reflect the diversity of the lesbian, gay,
21		bisexual, transgender, queer, plus community by

- 1	including individuals from different lesbian, gay,		
2	bisexual, transgender, queer, plus identities.		
3	(d) A chairperson of the commission shall be elected		
4	annually from the eight appointed members of the commission. A		
5	quorum to do business or validate any act of the commission		
6	shall consist of a majority of the eight appointed members of		
7	the commission.		
8	§ -4 Compensation. The members of the commission shall		
9	serve without compensation but shall be reimbursed for expenses,		
10	including travel expenses, necessary for the performance of		
11	their duties.		
12	§ -5 Powers and duties of the commission. The		
13	commission shall:		
14	(1) Act as a central clearinghouse and coordinating body		
15	for governmental and nongovernmental activities and		
16	information relating to the status of the lesbian,		
17	gay, bisexual, transgender, queer, plus community in		
18	the State;		
19	(2) Create public awareness and understanding of the		
20	responsibilities, needs, potentials, and contributions		
21	of the lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer,

1	plus community and their roles in the changing
2	society;
3 (3) Recommend legislative and administrative action on
4	equal treatment and opportunities for members of the
5	lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer, plus
6	community;
7 (4) Encourage a long-range program of education of members
8	of the lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer,
9	plus community in their political rights and
10	responsibilities, particularly with respect to their
11	voting duties;
12 (5) Maintain contacts with appropriate federal, state,
13	local, and international agencies concerned with the
14	status of the lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender,
15	queer, plus community;
16 (6) Cooperate and collaborate with national groups on the
17	status of the lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender,
18	queer, plus community and arrange for participation by
19	representatives of the State in White House
20	conferences and other national conferences;

1	(7)	Administer funds allocated for the commission's work,
2		including accepting, disbursing, and allocating funds
3		that may become available from other governmental and
4		private sources; provided that all funds shall be
5		disbursed or allocated in compliance with any specific
6		designation stated by the donor; provided further that
7		in the absence of any specific designation, the funds
8		shall be disbursed or allocated to projects related to
9		any of the purposes of this chapter; and
10	(8)	Submit to the governor and legislature an annual
11		report with recommendations."
12	SECT	ION 2. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2060.
