H.C.R. No. 72 entitled:

"HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION URGING THE OFFICE OF YOUTH
SERVICES AND DISTRICT FAMILY COURT OF THE FIRST JUDICIAL
CIRCUIT TO COLLABORATE IN IDENTIFYING PROCESSES, PROCEDURES,
AND STRATEGIES FOR PARTNERING WITH COMMUNITY ORGANIZATIONS TO
MAXIMIZE REHABILITATION AND MINIMIZE RECIDIVISM FOR JUVENILE

The purpose of this measure is to urge the Office of Youth
Services and the Family Court of the First Judicial Circuit to
collaborate in identifying processes, procedures, and strategies
for partnering with community organizations to maximize
rehabilitation and minimize recidivism for juvenile offenders.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure
from the Hawaii Youth Services Network. Your Committee received
comments on this measure from the Office of Youth Services, and
The Judiciary of the State of Hawaii.

Your Committee amended this measure by:

(1) deleting all references to "District Family Court of the
First Judicial Circuit" in the title and body of this
