# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATE FOUNDATION ON CULTURE AND THE ARTS.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to specify the
2	membership and qualifications for membership of the state
3	foundation on culture and the arts commission.
4	SECTION 2. Section 9-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
5	amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
6	"(b) The foundation shall be governed by a policymaking
7	and oversight commission to be known as the state foundation on
8	culture and the arts commission. The commission shall be
9	composed of [ <del>nine</del> ] <u>eleven</u> members [ <del>to</del> ], nine of whom shall be
10	voting members appointed and removed by the governor pursuant to
11	section 26-34[ $\cdot$ ], and two of whom shall be ex officio, nonvoting
12	members.
13	The governor shall appoint voting members who:
14	(1) By reason of education or extensive experience, are
15	generally recognized as having demonstrated
16	accomplishment or expertise in the fields of culture,

17 the arts, history, and the humanities; and

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1	(2) Are familiar with the people and cultures of Hawaii.		
2	Further, the governor shall ensure that, of the voting members		
3	appointed, at least one member has a background or experience in		
4	each of the following: the needs of public educators; neighbor		
5	island communities; native Hawaiian culture and diversity; and		
6	urban design and public infrastructure.		
7	The chair of the senate and house of representatives		
8	standing committees with primary jurisdiction over culture and		
9	the arts shall serve as the two ex officio, nonvoting members of		
10	the commission.		
11	The term of each voting member shall be for four years,		
12	commencing on July 1 and expiring on June 30; provided that for		
13	terms commencing on or after July 1, 1999, the governor shall		
14	appoint at least one member who resides in the county of Hawaii,		
15	one member who resides in the county of Kauai, and one member		
16	who resides in the county of Maui.		
17	The governor shall appoint the chairperson of the		
18	commission from among its voting members. The members of the		
19	commission shall serve without compensation, but shall be		
20	reimbursed for travel and other necessary expenses in the		
21	performance of their official duties."		

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SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

3 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
