
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and
4 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
5 year 2024-2025 to support the aquaculture disease diagnostic
6 laboratory at the state veterinary laboratory building in the
7 department of agriculture animal industry division veterinary
8 laboratory services branch, in partnership with the University
9 of Hawaii college of tropical agriculture; provided that the
10 sums shall be allocated as follows:

11 (1) \$ to support the aquaculture disease
12 diagnostic lab in its development of the aquaculture
13 production industry;

14 (2) \$ for one full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE)
15 permanent state aquaculture veterinarian position;



1 (3) \$ for two full-time equivalent (2.0 FTE)
2 microbiologist III (SR-20) positions to support the
3 recently hired veterinary medical officer III; and
4 (4) \$ for lab staff, equipment, and supplies to
5 support the marine shrimp broodstock, koi, and oyster
6 export efforts and the day-to-day support for the
7 larger aquaculture production industry.

8 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
9 of agriculture for the purposes of this Act.

10 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect on June 30, 3000.
