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## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE GENERAL EXCISE TAX.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. Section 237-24.9, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:

3 "(b) As used in this section:

4 "Aircraft" means any [~~eraft~~]:

5 (1) Craft or artificial contrivance of whatever  
6 description engaged in intrastate, interstate, or  
7 international scheduled commercial use as defined in  
8 chapter 263, that operates with two or more jet  
9 engines[-]; or

10 (2) Helicopter.

11 "Aircraft service and maintenance" means all scheduled and  
12 unscheduled tasks performed within an aircraft service and  
13 maintenance facility for the inspection, modification,  
14 maintenance, and repair of aircraft and related components  
15 including engines, hydraulic and electrical systems, and all  
16 other components which are an integral part of an aircraft.



1 "Aircraft service and maintenance facility" means a  
2 facility for aircraft service and maintenance that [~~is not~~]:  
3 (1) Services and maintains jet aircraft and is no less  
4 than thirty thousand square feet in area, [~~and~~] which  
5 may include ancillary space [~~which~~] that is integral  
6 to the facility, such as parts and inventory warehouse  
7 space, tool rooms, and related administrative and  
8 employee space[~~+~~]; or  
9 (2) Services and maintains helicopters and in which no  
10 less than seventy-five per cent of the helicopters  
11 serviced and maintained annually are equipped with  
12 quiet technology.

13 "Construction of an aircraft service and maintenance  
14 facility" means all design, engineering, labor, and material  
15 costs associated with the construction of facilities the  
16 [~~+~~]principal[~~+~~] purpose of which is the provision of facilities  
17 for aircraft service and maintenance.

18 "Maintenance" means the upkeep of aircraft engines,  
19 hydraulic and electrical systems, and all other components which  
20 are an integral part of an aircraft, but does not include  
21 refueling, janitorial services or cleaning, restocking of



1 aircraft and passenger supplies, or loading or unloading of  
2 cargo and passenger baggage.

3 "Quiet technology" means the use of design, technologies,  
4 and structure modifications to rotocraft to reduce or redirect  
5 the sound generated by the engine exhaust, tail, or the main  
6 rotor, and that reduces the craft's total overall noise level by  
7 at least \_\_\_\_\_ decibels."

8 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
9 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

10 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2024,  
11 and shall be repealed on December 31, 2028; provided that  
12 section 237-24.9(b), Hawaii Revised Statutes, shall be reenacted  
13 in the form in which it read on the day prior to the effective  
14 date of this Act.

**Report Title:**

General Excise Tax; Helicopters; Service and Maintenance Facility; Quiet Technology; Exemption; Sunset

**Description:**

Establishes a five-year general excise tax exemption beginning 1/1/24 for amounts received from the servicing and maintenance of helicopters in an aircraft service and maintenance facility or from the construction of a facility that services and maintains helicopters where at least 75 percent of the helicopters serviced and maintained annually in the facility are equipped with quiet technology. Sunsets 12/31/2028.
