RELATING TO THE GENERAL EXCISE TAX.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 237-24.9, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
3	"(b) As used in this section:
4	"Aircraft" means any [craft] <u>:</u>
5	(1) Craft or artificial contrivance of whatever
6	description engaged in intrastate, interstate, or
7	international scheduled commercial use as defined in
8	chapter 263, that operates with two or more jet

10	(2) Helicopter.
11	"Aircraft service and maintenance" means all scheduled and
12	unscheduled tasks performed within an aircraft service and
13	maintenance facility for the inspection, modification,
14	maintenance, and repair of aircraft and related components
15	including engines, hydraulic and electrical systems, and all
16	other components [which] <u>that</u> are an integral part of an
17	aircraft.

aircraft and passenger supplies, or loading or unloading of 1 2 cargo and passenger baggage. 3 "Quiet technology" means the use of design, technologies, 4 and structure modifications to rotorcraft to reduce or redirect 5 the sound generated by the engine exhaust, tail, or the main 6 rotor, utilizing either a shrouded tail rotor or removing the 7 tail rotor." 8 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 9 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000, and 10 11 shall be repealed on December 31, 2028; provided that section 237-24.9(b), Hawaii Revised Statutes, shall be reenacted in the 12 form in which it read on the day prior to the effective date of 13 14 this Act.

General Excise Tax; Helicopters; Service and Maintenance Facility; Quiet Technology; Exemption; Sunset

Description:

Establishes a temporary general excise tax exemption for amounts received from the servicing and maintenance of helicopters in an aircraft service and maintenance facility outside any Hawaii airport or from the construction of a facility that services and maintains helicopters where at least 75% of the helicopters serviced and maintained annually in the facility are equipped with quiet technology. Effective 7/1/3000. Sunsets 12/31/2028. (SD2)
