HOUSE RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE TO DESIGNATE KUNIA, LEILEHUA PLATEAU, AND POAMOHO AS THE CENTRAL OAHU AGRICULTURAL CORRIDOR AND TO ESTABLISH A LIST PRIORITIZING POTENTIAL AGRICULTURAL INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS THAT WOULD PROVIDE THE MOST VALUE TO THE STATE.

WHEREAS, the farmlands of Kunia and Wahiawa were once major 1 areas of pineapple production in the State; and 2 3 WHEREAS, since the downsizing of Hawaii's pineapple 4 industry, both the State and private landowners have diversified 5 farming on former pineapple plantation lands; and 6 7 WHEREAS, Hawaii imports nearly eight-five percent of the 8 food it consumes, and a natural disaster or global event has the 9 potential to significantly disrupt Hawaii's food supply; and 10 11 WHEREAS, the State has set a goal to double local food 12 production by 2030; and 13 14 WHEREAS, significantly increasing diversified farming in 15 Hawaii will require new infrastructure, including roads and 16 water systems integrated to match the needs of farmers; and 17 18 WHEREAS, the State and counties should consider agriculture 19 in long-term state and county planning; now, therefore, 20 21 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 22 Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 23 Session of 2023, that the Department of Agriculture is urged to 24 designate Kunia, Leilehua Plateau, and Poamoho as the Central 25 Oahu Agricultural Corridor; and 26 27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Agriculture 28 is requested to establish a list prioritizing potential 29 agricultural infrastructure improvement projects that would 30 31 provide the most value to the State when considering: 32



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- (1)The estimated increase in agricultural production if 1 the recommended infrastructure improvement project is 2 implemented; 3 4 The estimated cost of the recommended infrastructure 5 (2) improvement project; 6 7 (3) County plans; 8 9 County zoning and land use; (4) 10 11 State land use; and 12 (5) 13 (6) Any other factors the Department of Agriculture finds 14 relevant; and 15 16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Agriculture 17 is requested to submit a report containing its list and related 18 findings, recommendations, and proposed legislation, if any, to 19 the Legislature no later than twenty days prior to the Regular 20 Session of 2024; and 21 22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this 23 Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the Board of 24 25 Agriculture. 26 OFFERED BY: Car Q.5 27 28

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
