HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE JUDICIARY TO PREPARE A MASTER DEVELOPMENT PLAN, INCLUDING A CAPITOL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT REQUEST, TO UPGRADE THE SOUTH KOHALA DISTRICT COURT.

1 WHEREAS, the South Kohala District Court complex is located in Waimea, which is a one-hour drive from both Hilo and Kona, 2 the two larger population centers on Hawaii island; and 3 4 WHEREAS, the population of Waimea has nearly doubled in 5 twenty years from seven thousand to nearly fourteen thousand 6 residents: and 7 8 WHEREAS, neighboring communities in North Kohala, Kawaihae, 9 Waikoloa, Hamakua, Waikii, and the South Kohala Coast rely on 10 crucial government services in Waimea, including access to the 11 District Court; and 12 13 14 WHEREAS, Waimea needs a bigger District Court complex, a District Court Judge, and Circuit Court Judge to serve the large 15 geographical area and its growing population; and 16 17 WHEREAS, the current complex does not have adequate seating 18 capacity and people often must wait outside; some days as many 19 as fifty individuals are forced to wait outside; and 20 21 22 WHEREAS, Waimea is at nearly a two thousand seven hundredfoot elevation level and is exposed to trade winds and rain; and 23 24 WHEREAS, the restroom facilities are inadequate with just 25 one male and one female restroom, with one stall each, and are 26 27 located within the security check point and not easily accessible to the parties waiting outside; and 28 29 30 WHEREAS, the public has been told that they cannot file family court documents at the South Kohala District Court, 31 forcing them to go to either Hilo or Kona; and 32



1 WHEREAS, for temporary restraining order cases, there is no 2 separate waiting area for the opposing parties, which creates 3 stressful, if not dangerous, situations in which the opposing 4 parties may encounter each other outside of the courtroom; and 5 6 WHEREAS, this serious lack of judiciary facilities in South 7 Kohala can only be remedied by an objective evaluation of the 8 demand for these facilities and a determination of how these 9 needs can be met; and 10 11 WHEREAS, this evaluation and analysis would provide the 12 necessary information to prepare a master development plan to 13 upgrade the South Kohala District Court complex; now, therefore, 14 15 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 16 Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 17 Session of 2023, that the Judiciary is requested to prepare a 18 master development plan for the South Kohala District Court 19 complex, including a cost estimate to plan, design, and 20 construct the upgraded facility as a capital improvement 21 22 project; and 23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Judiciary is requested to 24 submit a capital improvement project request for the planning, 25 design, and construction for an upgraded South Kohala District 26 Court to the Legislature no later than twenty days prior to the 27 convening of the Regular Session of 2024; and 28 29 30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Resolution be transmitted to the Chief Justice and Administrator 31 Director of the Courts. 32 33 34 Jar 35 OFFERED BY: MAR 1 0 2023



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
