A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO WATER TESTING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that there is only one
- 2 water quality testing laboratory on the island of Maui.
- 3 laboratory is operated by the county of Maui and only serves the
- 4 county's agencies. The legislature also finds that all other
- 5 water quality testing must be sent to the island of Oahu and
- takes up to twelve weeks to be returned. The legislature 6
- 7 believes that a water testing laboratory at the university of
- 8 Hawaii Maui college will not only allow for faster water quality
- 9 test results but will also provide opportunities for further
- 10 water quality research on the island of Maui.
- 11 The legislature notes that in 2022, the island of Maui
- 12 experienced a water quality crisis when wastewater leaked from
- 13 condominium injection wells into the island's coastline.
- 14 island of Oahu experienced a similar crisis when fuel leaked
- 15 into the island's drinking water from the Red Hill underground
- 16 fuel storage facility. Given these and other water quality
- 17 crises, the legislature finds that water quality testing is

- 1 imperative to the health of the State's environment and
- 2 residents.
- 3 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to fund and staff a
- 4 water testing laboratory at the university of Hawaii Maui
- 5 college.
- 6 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 7 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$215,000 or so much
- 8 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and the
- 9 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 10 2024-2025 to support water testing at the department of science
- 11 of the university of Hawaii Maui college. The moneys shall be
- 12 allocated as follows:
- 13 (1) \$100,000 annually for one full-time equivalent (1.0
- 14 FTE) laboratory coordinator having a doctoral degree
- in water science;
- 16 (2) \$65,000 annually for one full-time equivalent (1.0
- 17 FTE) laboratory assistant having a bachelor's degree
- in marine science or biology; and
- 19 (3) \$50,000 annually for laboratory supplies and testing
- supplies.

- 1 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the university
- 2 of Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
