BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. (a) The department of transportation, in
 conjunction with the city and county of Honolulu, shall develop
 a pilot program to use noise detection traffic cameras to
 address excessive traffic noise in urban areas on the island of
 Oahu.

6 (b) The department of transportation shall submit a report
7 of its findings and recommendations, including any proposed
8 legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior
9 to the convening of the regular session of 2025.

SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 for the purposes of this Act.

15 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department 16 of transportation for the purposes of this Act.
