Your Committee on Transportation and Culture and the Arts, to which was referred S.B. No. 2178 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO ROADS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose and intent of this measure is to allow for a percentage of general excise and fuel taxes generated by the counties to be used for maintenance of private roadways that are open to the public.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from one individual.

Your Committee received comments on this measure from the Department of the Attorney General and Tax Foundation of Hawaii.

Your Committee finds that there has been an increase in utilization of streets, highways, thoroughfares, and roadways, and their surrounding areas that has resulted in an influx of traffic that exceeds their original design capacity. Currently, counties are prohibited from utilizing taxes to conduct maintenance on privately-owned roads that are open to the public. This measure will authorize counties to use county taxes for the reconstruction, improvement, repair, and maintenance of privatelyowned roadways that are open to the public to increase public safety and the general welfare of the State.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:

- Inserting legislative findings declaring that it is in the public interest to improve and maintain private roadways that serve the public, in limited circumstances;
- (2) Inserting an effective date of January 1, 2050, to encourage further discussion; and
- (3) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for the purposes of clarity and consistency.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Transportation and Culture and the Arts that is attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of S.B. No. 2178, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Second Reading in the form attached hereto as S.B. No. 2178, S.D. 1, and be referred to your Committee on Ways and Means.
