A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIFORM PROBATE CODE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to correct an
2 oversight in Act 158, Session Laws of Hawaii 2023, which updated
3 articles I through IV of the Uniform Probate Code to adjust for
4 inflation, clarify provisions, resolve issues that have arisen
5 in probate practice, and address societal changes in familial
6 relations. Specifically, this Act reduces the number of
7 required publications of a notice to creditors by a trustee to
8 once a week for two successive weeks, consistent with the
9 amendments Act 158 made to publication requirements applicable
10 to probate matters generally.

11 SECTION 2. Section 560:3-801, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
12 amended by amending subsection (f) to read as follows:

13 "(f) The trustee or successor trustee of any trust created
14 by the decedent may publish a notice to creditors once a week
15 for [~~three~~] two successive weeks in a newspaper of general
16 circulation in the judicial circuit in which either:

17 (1) The decedent was domiciled; or



1 (2) An application or petition for appointment of personal
 2 representative is filed announcing the trustee's name
 3 and address, and notifying creditors of the decedent
 4 to present their claims to the trustee within four
 5 months after the date of the first publication of the
 6 notice or be forever barred.

7 The notice may be combined with the published notice of the
 8 pendency of any probate or appointment proceedings."

9 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
 10 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

11 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.


