A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Act 4, First Special Session Laws of Hawaii
2 2021, is amended by amending section 1 to read as follows:
3 "SECTION 1. ~~[(a)]~~ The department of health may require
4 the department of education ~~[shall publish a weekly]~~ to report
5 on ~~[schools that have a student, staff member, or affiliated~~
6 ~~individual who has tested positive for]~~ coronavirus disease 2019
7 ~~[(COVID-19)]. The report shall include:~~
8 ~~(1) The school's name;~~
9 ~~(2) The date the COVID-19 positive test result was~~
10 ~~reported to the school; and~~
11 ~~(3) The date that the positively tested individual was~~
12 ~~last on the school campus.~~
13 ~~(b) The report shall be published weekly commencing after~~
14 ~~July 1, 2021, on the department of education's website.]~~
15 potential outbreaks or other public health emergencies and
16 related information in a manner most appropriate to public
17 health and safety, as determined by the department of health.



1 The department of health shall not require the department of
2 education to include in any report personally identifiable
3 information or education records, as provided in title 20 United
4 States Code section 1232g and title 34 Code of Federal
5 Regulations section 99.3; provided that the department of
6 education may provide personally identifiable information only
7 after the department of education has determined that a health
8 or safety emergency exists."

9 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
10 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.


