

### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO VESSELS.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that as working harbors,
- 2 many of Hawai'i's harbors produce large amounts of noise. While
- 3 the department of transportation has the authority to adopt
- 4 rules regulating the manner in which vessels may enter and moor,
- 5 anchor, or dock in the commercial harbors, ports, and
- 6 roadsteads, this authority does not allow the department of
- 7 transportation to adopt rules to regulate excessive and harmful
- 8 noises emanating from these vessels. The legislature further
- 9 finds that granting the department of transportation this
- 10 authority will help alleviate the concerns of individuals
- 11 affected by the noise from Hawai'i's harbors.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 266-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 13 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- 14 "(a) The director of transportation may adopt rules as
- 15 necessary:
- 16 (1) To regulate the manner in which all vessels may enter
- 17 and moor, anchor, or dock in the commercial harbors,

5	(2)	For the examination, guidance, and control of harbor

8	(3)	For the embarking or disembarking of passengers;
9	(4)	To regulate the allowable noise that may emanate from
10		vessels while using the commercial harbors, ports,
11		roadsteads, docks, wharves, piers, quays, bulkheads,
12		and landings of the State, including by establishing
13		noise limits;
14	[ <del>(4)</del> ]	(5) For the expeditious and careful handling of
15		freight, goods, wares, and merchandise of every kind
16		which may be delivered for shipment or discharged on
17		the commercial docks, wharves, piers, quays,
18		bulkheads, or landings belonging to or controlled by
19		the State; and
20	[ <del>(5)</del> -]	(6) To define the duties and powers of carriers,
21		shippers, and consignees respecting passengers,

1	freight, goods, wares, and merchandise in and upon the
2	docks, wharves, piers, quays, bulkheads, or landings
3	within the commercial harbors, ports, and roadsteads
4	of the State."
5	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
6	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
7	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
